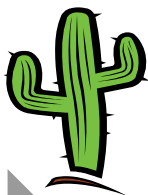

Welcome Exhibitors!

Collman Equestrian Productions is excited to announce a new series of hunter jumper horse shows at the beautiful Horseshoe Park & Equestrian Center (HPEC) in Queen Creek, Arizona. These shows will operate a little differently than the ones you are used to ... these shows will emphasize convenience and affordability. Shows that are designed around what professionals want and what kids and adults need. Welcome to the 2012 Cactus Classic / Hunt Cup Horse Show Series!

These shows are four-day USEF "A" rated hunter jumper shows, with a one-day Hunt Cup Schooling Show each Sunday. The schedule is divided into professional and open classes on Thursday and Friday, then junior and amateur classes on Saturday and Sunday (except the four Junior / AO Jumper classes that go on Thursday and Friday). For our valued trainers ... two days to show all of your horses without having to worry about schooling clients for their classes at the same time. For the greatest parents ... you won't have to take your kids out of school on Fridays and rush them to the show by a certain time for their class. And for the vast majority of our awesome adults that actually work for a living ... no more having to take Friday off from work and lose the income or waste precious vacation days.

Stalls will be more affordable and flexible. Regular weekly stall fees are now only \$150; for those of you wanting to bring your horse on Friday and show through the weekend, there is a Weekend Stall Fee of \$100. Plus, you can enter a show by the entry closing date and not risk losing your stall fee if you cannot attend ... follow the show scratch process correctly, and you can transfer your stall fee to the next show.

Feed and bedding will now be handled through the horse show office. Forms will be available at the office or online at the CEP website. Competitors can place their orders on their account. Trainers can place their orders on their trainer account and either settle it, or have it split amongst their clients. RV spaces will be handled by the facility, so you can contact them directly (480-285-9331) to reserve yours.

CEP will now be accepting credit cards. You may use your Visa, Mastercard or Discover card (sorry, no American Express) to pay for your final bill at check-out. Entry deposits, when sending in your entry, must still be paid with a check. Please note that there will be a 3% Fee for all credit card transactions.

Finally, a word about braiding. You are welcomed, but not required, to braid your horses for the USEF "A" rated hunter classes and national medal classes at these shows (it is NOT a USEF rule that you must braid for hunter jumper classes). But we strongly discourage braiding for all "C", unrated / local and local equitation and medal classes. Judges will not penalize unbraided horses in these classes.

Friendly staff, quality officiating, a new and improved facility, more affordability and a fun time. What else could you possibly want or need? Oh yeah ... and someone actually thought about how a facility should be designed so that delivery trucks don't go head-to-head with ponies and there is no chance that a hot rod car will burn-out and spook a horse ... and there are two parking lots and a simple traffic pattern for everyone! After all these years with the parking and traffic challenges in Scottsdale, that alone makes me so happy!

### FEED & BEDDING

Feed and bedding is available every day except Sundays. Orders should be placed at the horse show office and can be added to your horse show account. Orders placed by 12:00 noon will be delivered the same day. Orders placed after 12:00 noon will be delivered the next day (exception: no orders will be accepted after 12:00 noon on Saturdays since there are no deliveries on Sundays).

### TRAINER SPLIT FORM

Trainers, you may place your feed and bedding orders, tack / feed / grooming stalls and turn-out paddocks for your barn on a Trainer Split Form. This form must be completed and turned into the horse show office by 12:00 noon on Saturdays. Clients that have checked out prior to this time will NOT be included in the split. Forms submitted to the office after 12:00 noon on Saturdays will not be honored.

### ARRIVALS and DEPARTURES

Stalls may be set-up and horses may arrive anytime after 9:00am on Tuesdays. Horses must depart not later than 10:00am on Mondays.

### SCHOOLING POLICY

**Hunter Rings** - Open schooling is permitted on warm-up days (Wednesdays) from 10am to 5pm. Each morning during the show, hunter rings are open for schooling up until 30 minutes before their start time. Each afternoon, rings may be open for schooling after being reset. No schooling will be permitted after dark or 6pm.

**Jumper Ring** - Open on warm-up days (Wednesdays) for non-judged warm-up rounds at \$25 / round (see fence heights and times on Index To Classes page). Ticketed schooling (\$25 / ticket) over fences may be permitted in the afternoon during the show if time allows - check with show management each day.

To have these fees removed, proper proof must be provided to the office by 12:00 noon on Saturdays. After that time, those fees will apply without exception.

Horses must have entered and shown in at least one class in the 1.25m or 1.35m jumper section (Open or Jr/AO) at the same show. Entries electing the lower option will be shown over a course of fences at 1.25m (4'1") first. Clean rounds will remain in the ring and do their jump-off. Then the fences will be raised to 1.35m (4'5") and the remaining entries will jump their first round and, if clean, jump-off. USEF Table II; Sec 2b (Time First Jump-Off). Rider's must declare their height at the time of entry. Riders may change height prior to the start of the class but must go first in the order at their new height. Riders may not change heights once the class starts. Entries must be made by 4:00pm the day before the class. Entries after this time are subject to a \$25 Post Entry Fee and must go first in the order of their declared height. Scratches are allowed anytime up until the start of the class and will receive a refund of the original entry fee minus a \$50 Scratch Fee. Prize money through eighth divided \$750, \$500, \$325, \$250, \$200, \$175, \$150, \$150.

Horses must have entered and shown in at least two hunter classes over fences at the same show. Open to any horse and rider combination. No cross entry restrictions. To be shown over one round of at least 12 fences at 3'0" in height over a hunter derby-style course. Fences and courses to simulate obstacles found in trappy hunt country. #### Cactus Classic 1 (January 21)

##### **Class 503. Leadline 9 & Under**

Open to very beginner riders nine years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes at the same show. Properly fitted, approved hard hat and shoes / boots with at least a 1/2" heel required. Entry Fee: None

#### Cactus Classic 2 (April 14)

##### **Class 504. Walk-Trot 12 & Under**

Open to beginner riders twelve years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes at the same show. To be shown at the walk and trot both directions of the ring. Judged on steering, control of mount and proper position. Entry Fee: None

#### Cactus Classic 3 (April 21)

##### **Class 505. Games & Races**

Enter once and show in both classes! There will be a Bareback Sit-A-Buck Class (dollar bill under your knee or seat ... walk, trot and canter around ... bring your own dollar bill and winner gets all of the dollar bills!) and the Baseball Bat Spin Race (fastest walk on your horse you can do to the middle of ring ... trotting results in elimination ... dismount and spin around a bat five times, then run on foot back to the gate (we'll hold your horse). Fastest one wins! Entry Fee: None

#### Cactus Classic 4 (October 13)

##### **Class 506. \$250 Under Saddle Derby**

Open to any horse and rider. No entry requirements or restrictions. To be shown at the walk, trot, canter and hand gallop both directions of the ring. Judges may ask for a number of flatwork tests. No jumping. Entries called into the center of the ring one at a time until only the class winner remains on the rail. Prize money awarded to the top three entries at 50%, 30%, 20%. Entry Fee: None

#### Cactus Classic 5 (October 20)

##### **Class 507. Pre-Halloween Costume Class**

Open to all. No entry requirements or restrictions. To be shown at a walk and trot only, no cantering. Special prizes awarded for the best costumes in various categories to be determined by the judges. Properly fitted, approved hard hat and shoes / boots with at least a 1/2" heel required. Entry Fee: None

#### **NEXT DAY ADDS**

Adds for each show day must be made in the horse show office by 5:00pm the day before. After 5:00pm, full rings for the next day may be declared closed. If next day adds are accepted after 5:00pm, the post entry fee will apply.

#### **SAME DAY ADDS**

CEP allows same-day adds if the schedule in each ring allows for such. After 5:00pm each day, if the following day's schedule in a ring is full, then that ring is declared "closed" and will not allow same day adds. Exhibitors are urged to verify their entries daily for the next day.

# HORSE SHOW CHAMPIONSHIPS



**HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIPS:** In Hunter championships, the titles shall be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points over fences. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in Under Saddle classes and Model classes. Ties in Hunter Championships shall be broken as specified in the USEF Rule Book. All others will remain tied and shall receive equal awards. Points Calculated: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2.

**JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIPS:** In all Jumper championships, points for all but the last class in each section shall be calculated 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2. The final class in each section will be a Bonus Point Class and shall count 15, 9, 6, 3, 2, 1. In case of a tie for champion or reserve, the winner shall be the entry with more points from the Bonus Point Class. If still tied (due to neither entry having earned points in the Bonus Point Class), and one entry competed in the Bonus Point Class and the other did not, the entry that competed would be declared the winner. If still tied, then the entries shall remain tied and receive equal awards.

**COMBINED SECTION CHAMPIONSHIPS:** For all sections in which there are hunter, equitation and/or pleasure classes contained, all classes shall count equally for points and the champion will be entry with the highest overall point total. In case of a tie for champion or reserve, the winner shall be: 1) the entry with the most points over fences; if still tied: 2) the entry with the most points in the equitation flat class. Points calculated: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2.

Non-showing horses are permitted at all CEP shows. If a stall is needed, contact CEP 3-5 days prior to each show to verify availability. All non-showing horses must pay for a stall if using one. The following is the policy regarding non-showing horses:

- Owners that have actively showing horses may bring non-showing horses at no charge.
- Owners that do not have a horse actively competing may bring non-showing horses and pay a \$50 Non-Showing Horse Fee.

## HUNTERS / COMBINED SECTIONS

---

**GREEN WORKING HUNTERS** - A green hunter is a horse of any age in his first or second year of showing at USEF recognized shows in classes with fences 3'6" or higher. 1st Year horses to jump 3'6" and 2nd Year horses to jump 3'9".

**HIGH PERFORMANCE WORKING HUNTERS** - Open to any horse. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'9" at 'A' shows.

**PERFORMANCE WORKING HUNTER 3'6"** - Open to any horse. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'6".

**PERFORMANCE WORKING HUNTER 3'3"** - Open to any horse. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'3".

**JUNIOR WORKING HUNTERS** - Open to horses of any age and ridden by a junior exhibitor. Horse/rider combination is restricted from showing in both Children's and Junior Hunter sections at the same show. All horses showing at a regular member show in the Junior Hunter section must have a current USEF measurement card. Fences 3'6".

**AMATEUR OWNER HUNTERS** - Horses to be ridden by an Amateur Owner or an amateur member of the owner's family. Horse/rider combination cannot show in both Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show. Fences 3'3" and 3'6".

**PONY HUNTERS** - All ponies must have a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by the USEF, and it must be shown in the horse show office BEFORE numbers are released. To be ridden by a junior exhibitor as per USEF age restrictions. Fences 2'3" for Small / 2'6" for Medium / 3'0" for Large Ponies. The first class over fences will be a Conformation class and shall count 75% performance and 25% conformation.

**PRE-GREEN HUNTERS** - A horse of any age that qualifies as a Pre-Green by current USEF Zone 8 specifications. Fences 3'0". No jog.

**CHILDREN'S HUNTERS** - Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor. The horse/rider combination is restricted from showing in both Junior Hunter and Children's Hunter sections at the same show. Fences 3'0". In-and-Outs will not be adjusted for ponies. No jog.

**ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS** - Open to horses ridden by Adult Amateur riders. The horse/rider combination cannot show in both Amateur Owner and Adult Amateur Hunter sections at the same show. Fences 3'0". No jog.

**CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTERS** - Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. Same pony / rider combination may not cross enter into the Regular Pony Hunter section at the same show. Fences 2'0" for Small and Medium; 2'6" for Large. Distances will not be adjusted. Spreads not to exceed fence height. No jog.

**EVERGREEN HUNTERS** - Open to any horse and rider. No cross entry restrictions. Trotting not to be penalized. No jog. Fences 2'3".

**MODIFIED LOW HUNTERS** - Open to any horse and rider. No cross entry restrictions. Trotting not to be penalized. No jog. Fences 2'6".

**BABY GREEN HUNTERS** - Open to any horse and rider combination. Trotting not to be penalized. No jog. Fences 2'6".

**TRAINING HUNTERS** - Open to any horse and rider combination. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 2'9". No jog.

**LOW HUNTERS** - Open to any horse and rider combination. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'0". No jog.

**SCHOOLING HUNTERS** - Open to any horse and rider combination. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'0". No jog.

**SCHOOLING PONY HUNTERS** - Open to ponies ridden by a junior. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 2'0" and 2'6" - may show at either height, regardless of pony size. Rider may change heights during a show. Distances will be on horse strides and will not be adjusted. No jog.

**BEGINNER RIDER SECTION** - For the beginning rider of any age who has NEVER shown over fences exceeding 2'6" and may not do so at the same show. Fences 2'3". No oxers. No jog.

**SHORT STIRRUP SECTION** - For the beginning junior rider 11 years of age and under who has NEVER shown over fences exceeding 2'6" and may not do so at the same show. Fences 2'3". No oxers. No jog.

**MEDIUM STIRRUP SECTION** - For the beginning junior rider 17 years of age and under who has NEVER shown over fences exceeding 2'9" and may not do so at the same show. Fences 2'6". No jog.

**LONG STIRRUP SECTION** - For the beginning adult rider 18 years of age and over who has NEVER shown over fences exceeding 2'9" and may not do so at the same show. Fences 2'6". No jog.

**NON-PRO HUNTERS** - Open to all non-professional riders. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 2'6". No jog.

**LOW CHILDREN'S / AA SECTION** - Open to any horse / rider. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 2'9". No jog.

**MODIFIED JUNIOR / AMATEUR HUNTERS** - Open to any horse ridden by a junior or amateur rider. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'3". No jog.

**AHJA Junior / Amateur Medal** - Open to any junior or amateur rider who is a current member in good standing of the Arizona Hunter Jumper Association. To be shown over not less than 8 fences at 3'3" in height. Course can be over hunter or jumper fences, but must be an advanced

equitation-type course and include a combination. At least the top four riders shall return for further testing. USEF Tests 1-19. Four entries are required to fill the class.

**AHJA Children's Medal** - Open to any junior rider who is a current member in good standing of the Arizona Hunter Jumper Association. Riders may not compete in any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show. To be shown over not less than 8 fences 3'0" in height. Course can be over hunter or jumper fences, but must be an equitation-type course and include a combination. At least the top four riders shall return for further testing. USEF Tests 1-19. Four entries are required to fill the class.

**AHJA Adult Medal** - Open to any adult amateur rider who is a current member in good standing of the Arizona Hunter Jumper Association. Riders may not compete in any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show. To be shown over not less than 8 fences 3'0" in height. Course can be over hunter or jumper fences, but must be an equitation-type course and include a combination. At least the top four riders shall return for further testing. USEF Tests 1-19. Four entries are required to fill the class.

**AHJA Mini Medal** - Open to riders who are current members in good standing of the Arizona Hunter Jumper Association that have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher at any USEF regular member competition. To be shown over not less than six fences at 2'6" in height. No combinations. At least the top four shall return for further testing. USEF Tests 1-9. Four entries are required to fill the class.

**AHJA Mini Maclay** - Open to riders who are current members in good standing of the Arizona Hunter Jumper Association that have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher at any USEF regular member competition. To be shown over not less than six fences at 2'6" in height. No combinations. After the over fences phase, the top six shall return for a group flat phase. Scores from each phase shall count equally. Martingales are permitted in the over fences phase only - no martingales in the flat phase. Four entries are required to fill the class.

**Children's Pony Medal** - Open to riders showing in the Children's Pony Hunter or Children's Pony Equitation section at this show (riders showing in the USEF Pony Hunter or regular Pony Equitation classes at this show are ineligible for this class). To be shown over at least 6 fences at 2'0" for Small & Medium; 2'6" for Large. Two tests (USEF 1-9) built into the course - no work-off. Two entries are required to fill the class.

**Greenway / CEP Mini Equitation Challenge** - Open to junior and adult riders. Riders may not show in any classes with fences 3' or higher at the same show. Course to consist of at least seven fences at 2'6". No combinations. At least two tests (USEF 1-9) built into the course. No work-off. Two entries are required to fill the class.

**Greenway / CEP Children's Equitation Challenge** - Open to junior riders. Riders may not show in classes with fences 3'6" or higher at the same show (exception: riders showing in the Children's Jumper section may compete in this class). Course to consist of at least eight fences at 3'0" - combinations optional. At least two tests (USEF 1-19) built into the course. No work-off. Two entries are required to fill the class.

**Greenway / CEP Adult Equitation Challenge** - Open to adult riders. Riders may not show in any classes with fences 3'6" or higher at the same show (exception: riders showing in the A/A Jumper section may compete in this class). Course to consist of at least eight fences at 3'0" - combinations optional. At least two tests (USEF 1-19) built into the course. No work-off. Two entries are required to fill the class.

## JUMPERS

**DEFINITION:** Horses entered in any 1.20m or above jumper class at this show are considered Nominated Jumpers. All others are considered non-Nominated Jumpers. A Declaration is an entry made for a class.

**JUMPER NOMINATING FEE:** Nominated jumpers must pay a Jumper Nominating Fee of \$50 by closing date of entries. After the closing date of entries, the Late Jumper Nominating Fee will be \$75. The Jumper Nominating Fee is fully refundable until the start of the show. Once the first class of the show commences, the Jumper Nominating Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, even if you didn't show in any of your classes.

**OTHER JUMPER SECTIONS:** All other jumper sections not requiring a Jumper Nominating Fee should just pay the per class fee and should enter these sections when submitting their entry blank or be subject to the class post entry penalty.

**HORSE RECORDING:** Horses wishing to accrue points / money won for USEF HOTY awards must be recorded with the USEF.

**JUMPER TABLES:** Refer to the Time Schedule.

**TIME ALLOWED:** The Time Allowed in regular jumper classes will be based on a speed of 350 m/m (382 yards per minute) and for ponies will be 328 m/m (360 yards per minute) and may be adjusted accordingly.

**TIES:** Ties involving first place shall be jumped off as specified. All other ties will be broken by time taken in the first round.

**ARENAS:** The Jumper Ring is 150'x300' and covered; the Jumper Warm-up is 150'x300' open; both rings have bedded sand footing.

**POLING:** Poling and the use of offsets are not permitted at anytime, anywhere on the show grounds.

**MARTINGALES / DRAW REINS:** In jumper classes offering less than \$1000, there is no restriction on martingale use. In jumper classes offering \$1000 - \$4999, only standing martingales or running martingales used in the conventional manner are permitted. In jumper classes offering \$5000 or more or classes restricted to young horses, only running martingales used in the conventional manner are permitted. Draw reins may only be used when schooling or in classes with less than \$1000.

**START TIME:** A competitor will have 45 seconds from the time the judge sounds an audible signal to cross between the start markers in the proper direction and start on course. Time on course will start if the 45 seconds elapses before the rider crosses through the start markers.

**ORDER OF GO:** To be established randomly either by computer or USEF Steward manual draw

**ATTIRE:** If a riding coat is not worn, riders must wear a shirt with a collar or a choker, neatly tucked into riding breeches.

## CACTUS CLASSIC HORSE SHOW SERIES \*\* GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

### ENTRY PROCEDURES:

- a) For each horse entered, send only the \$50 Entry Deposit, Stall Fee and any applicable Jumper Nominating Fee. If hauling in and not using a stall, send only the \$50 Entry Deposit, \$50 Grounds Fee and any applicable Jumper Nominating Fee. Only checks are accepted with deposits.
- b) The entry form MUST be completely filled out and include: horse's name and complete description, all classes entered and all required signatures (including parent / guardian in the case of a minor exhibitor).
- c) Enclose a check (credit cards are not accepted for deposits) that is completely filled out with the proper deposit amount that will be deposited on the entry closing date. You must then bring a signed, open check or credit card to the show for the remainder of your fees. NUMBERS WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT THIS SIGNED, OPEN CHECK OR CREDIT CARD IMPRINT LODGED WITH THE SHOW OFFICE.
- d) Entries received by the closing date and adhering to the entry procedure outlined will have the \$50 Entry Deposit credited to their horse's account. Late entries, incomplete entries and entries made at the show will be charged a \$50 Post Entry Fee.
- e) USEF, USHJA, USET, ASPCA, AHJA and various other organizations have specific requirements for entry and participation in certain or all classes at this competition. Proof of membership for owners, riders and trainers, USEF Pony and Junior Hunter measurement cards and horse recording numbers are among the items that sanctioning organizations require. Competitors are responsible for knowledge of the requisite rules and for providing the required data. Non-member and other fees must be assessed if these items are not available. Competitors may be refused entry into certain classes if required data is not provided.

**OFFICE FEE:** An Office Fee of \$35 per horse will be charged.

**STABLING:** Whether used for horses, feed or tack, stalls are permanent, 10'x10' with doors and rent for \$150 per week or \$100 per weekend (Fri-Sun). Stalls may not be shared or resold.

**GROUND'S FEE:** A one-time \$50.00 Grounds Fee will be charged for horses that are showing which have not purchased a stall (exception: no charge for horses showing in the Special Fun Saturday Classes only).

**ADDING REGULAR CLASSES:** If you wish to add a class after initially checking in and picking up your number, you must do so by 5pm the day before the class is to be held and you must add it on an Add / Scratch Form or Trainer Sheet. There will be no charge for this. Adds after 5pm or same day adds, if allowed, will be charged a \$10 per class fee. Same day adds MUST be done on an Add/Scratch Form, NOT a Trainer Sheet, and MUST be given to the starter BEFORE the start of the class that was added.

**SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES:** If you do not intend to show in a regular class you have entered, you MUST scratch it on an Add / Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the horse show office the day before the class is held. There will be no charge for this. Same day scratches will be charged a \$10 per class fee and must be done BEFORE the start of the class. Telling the starter at the back gate that you are not going or simply not showing up will result in forfeiture of the entry fee. STARTERS DO NOT HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO SCRATCH YOU FROM A CLASS.

**ADDING / SCRATCHING SPECIAL CLASSES:** Entries into the Rider's Choice Jumper Classic should be made by 4:00pm the day before the class is held. Entries after this time will pay a Post Entry Fee of \$25 and must go first in the order. Scratches from this class must be done in the horse show office by 4:00pm the day before the class is held. Scratches after this time will forfeit the entry fee unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch.

**JUMPER NOMINATING FEE:** Horses entered in any 1.20m and higher jumper class must be nominated and pay a \$50 Jumper Nominating Fee by closing date of entries. After the closing date of entries, the Late Jumper Nominating Fee will be \$75. See Jumper division rules for more information. The Jumper Nominating Fee is fully refundable at any time up until the start of the show. Once the first class of the show commences, the Jumper Nominating Fee is non-refundable for any reason, even if you didn't show in any of your classes.

**SHOW SCRATCH:** On or before the closing date of entries, all fees shall be refunded. **After the closing date of entries, the \$50 Entry Deposit is not refundable under any circumstances and is forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee. Stall Fees will be credited to the next show.** All scratches must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund; phone call scratches will not be considered. REFUND REQUESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE END OF THE SHOW. NO REFUND REQUESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER THE SHOW.

**EQUITATION ENTRIES:** Equitation riders must wear the number of the horse they are entered on. Numbers are assigned to horses, not riders. If a rider wishes to change horses for an equitation class, they may do so without penalty; however, the proper paperwork must be completed in the show office prior to the start of the class. Exhibitors changing horses without notifying the office will forfeit their entry fee on the original horse and be charged the entry fee plus an RDNE Fee on the new horse.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** With a vet's certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a show scratched horse under the following conditions:

- Both horses are owned by the same owner.
- The scratched horse has not shown in any classes.
- The scratched horse pays a \$50 Show Scratch Fee.
- The scratched horse's stall fee is transferred to the substituted horse.
- The substituted horse pays no late fee.
- The substituted horse pays no add fees when initially completing an entry blank and entering classes, but is subject to all of the rules after the entry blank is submitted and the number is picked up.

**RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense. A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$50.00)! Accounts will be given seven (7) days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the USEF for disciplinary action.

**RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter):** Entries that show in a class not properly entered will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$25.00 RDNE Fee. Starters are not responsible for keeping you out of classes.

**CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS:** CEP will accept Visa, Mastercard and Discover for payment of your final bill when you close-out in the horse show office. Credit cards are not accepted with your entry deposit prior to the show. All credit card transactions will incur a 3% Fee. Sorry, but American Express is not accepted.

## CACTUS CLASSIC HORSE SHOW SERIES \*\* GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

**PRIZEMONEY / AWARDS:** Prize money checks will be mailed or hand-delivered to the owner within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. Social Security number of OWNER or PAYEE is required before any prize money will be paid. All purses and add-backs shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 12%, 5th - 11% and 6th - 10%. Ribbons shall be awarded to eighth place in all regular classes and classics unless otherwise stated.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Horses entering Arizona must have a current health certificate and negative coggins. For information, contact the Arizona State Veterinarian's Office at (602) 542-4293.

**FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** The legend "U.S. Funds" must be printed on the face of any check drawn on a foreign bank and used to pay any fees for these shows. Entries received that do not adhere to this policy will be returned. No exceptions.

**MONEY / STAKE CLASS ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible for a money, stake and/or jackpot class, entry must have entered and shown in at least two other classes in the section at the show, unless otherwise stated.

**RVs:** RV hook-ups (water and electric) are available on the grounds. Reservations must be made by contacting the HPEC office at (480) 285-9331. Upon arrival, all RVs must check-in with the HPEC office (NOT the horse show office) for payment arrangements and assignment of space. Sorry, reservations or payments cannot be made through the horse show.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES / GOLF CARTS:** In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**DOGS:** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards.

**PARKING:** The parking of vehicles and horse trailers is not permitted in the barn areas. Illegal parking anywhere will result in a fine of \$50 per occurrence. This fine will be placed on your horse show account and becomes a part of your financial obligation to the show. Further fines, ticketing and/or towing will result for multiple offenders.

**SECTION ENTRY FEES:** After showing in the first class of any section requiring a section entry fee, no refunds will be given for scratching any classes within the section for any reason.

**MANURE:** Manure must be placed in designated manure bins in the barn area. Do not place trash in manure bins. Violations are \$50 per occurrence.

**ADD BACK PRIZE MONEY:** In classes with add backs, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show. Horses entered but not shown will forfeit their add back.

**MEDICAL WASTE:** Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management.

**DAMAGE / HOLES IN STALLS & BARN WALLS:** Exhibitors will be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees, and will be billed accordingly. Holes punched in any stall or barn wall, or any use of an existing hole, will result in a fine of \$25 per hole punched or used, regardless of who made the hole. Facility staff inspect stalls daily and will charge the horse show for any violations of this rule.

**CONFLICTS:** Management cannot allow conflicts to hold up any rings. Riders with potential conflicts must arrange their jumping order with the starters so that they will not hold up a class. Trainer conflicts cannot be recognized. If you are a trainer, be sure to bring enough help to get your horses and clients to the rings in a timely manner or only bring a manageable number of horses if you are limited in the amount of help you have. **PLEASE DO NOT FORCE MANAGEMENT TO SCRATCH YOU FROM ANY CLASSES.** Doing so will result in forfeiture of entry fees for any classes you were scratched from.

**SHAVINGS:** Local laws will supersede USEF GR1216.7. Competitors are prohibited from bringing their own shavings onto HPEC property for either personal or commercial use. Shavings must be purchased through the feed and bedding concession on the grounds.

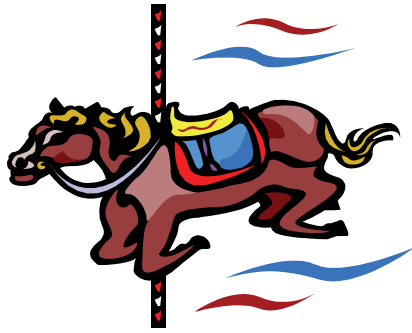
**TRAINER SPLITS:** These shows offer a service that allows trainers to have their tack, feed and grooming stalls, feed and bedding and turn-out paddocks split evenly amongst their client's horse show bills by completing a Trainer Split Form. All Trainer Split Forms are due on Saturday at 12:00 noon. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Clients who check out prior to 12:00 noon on Saturday will not be included in the split. Uncollected splits will revert back to the trainer.

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** All exhibitors are required to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, all juniors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitted headgear. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** Regulations prohibit alcohol being brought onto the grounds.

**USEF RULE GR901.11:** The horse show policies stated herein regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of USEF Rule GR901.11.

**ARENAS:** Jumper Ring is 150'x300' and is covered; jumper warm-up is 150'x300'; Hunter 1 is 150'x270'; Hunter 2 is 150'x240'; hunter warm-up is 150'x200'. All rings have bedded sand footing.

## RULES, REGULATIONS & GENERAL INFORMATION

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in classes, or make any changes management deems in the best interests of the show.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the show, its members, directors and employees, facility and Collman Equestrian Productions harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

**1) ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE** - Horses may arrive anytime after 7:00am on Sunday mornings. Early arrivals on Saturday are permitted if arranged for in advance. This is considered an overnight stall and is \$60 per stall. All horses must depart by Sunday evening. Contact CEP at [cepshows@aol.com](mailto:cepshows@aol.com) to arrange for early arrivals if needed.

**2) STALLS / HAUL-IN FEE** - HC Day Stalls (7:00am to close Sunday) are \$40. HC Overnight Stalls (Saturday to close Sunday) are \$60. Haul-ins (Sunday only - no stall) are \$20. All horses must pay either a Stall Fee or Haul-In Fee.

**3) ENTRIES** - Entries may be filled out at the show with no penalty. To encourage pre-entries, those wishing to fully complete an entry blank, attach a check paid in full and mail it in postmarked by the entry deadline listed on each entry blank will receive a 10% discount off of their actual class entry fees. If you choose to do this, simply add up your entry fees, then deduct 10% off. Then add your other fees in and this will give you your total. This discount only applies to your entry fees - stall, haul-in, early arrival, office and AHJA fees not included. If you pre-enter, then don't show for any reason, you will receive a refund minus the \$20 Office Fee. Upon checking in at the horse show office, all competitors must first lodge a signed, open check or credit card with the office before numbers will be released. This will cover any costs associated with adding or scratching classes during the show. If no changes are made, then this will be returned upon check-out.

**4) ATTIRE / EQUIPMENT** - Proper basic show attire for the rider includes boots / jodhpur boots and britches and collared shirts (hunt coats optional). USEF rules will be followed for equipment for the horse. In any case, footwear with at least a 1/2" heel is required. A hard hat is mandatory for all riders while mounted. Martingales are prohibited in all under saddle and pleasure classes. All other questions regarding tack and equipment shall be at the sole discretion of the judge and/or show management, their decision to be final.

**5) RETURNED CHECKS** - Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled according to the following procedure: A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$25)! Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the Maricopa County Attorney's Office for prosecution.

**6) FEED & BEDDING** - FEED AND BEDDING WILL BE AVAILABLE STARTING AT 7:00am - THOSE WITH DAY STALLS, PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE THIS TIME, AS YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GET BEDDING BEFORE 7:00am. Early arrivals on Saturday must pre-order their feed and bedding before 12:00 noon on Saturdays. For Pre-Orders, email CEP at [cepshows@aol.com](mailto:cepshows@aol.com).

**7) SCHOOLING** - Open schooling in the show ring will be available on Sunday from 7:00am to 8:00am. Proper hardhat and footwear mandatory at all times while in the ring. Schooling is only available to horses entered in the show. Early arrivals on Saturday may school in the ring from 2:00pm until 5:00pm unless it is being used by the Cactus Classic show.

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

**Walk-Trot Section** - open to beginner riders. Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences exceeding 12" at the same show. Courses to be once around outside lines with poles on the ground.

**Crossrail Rider Section** - open to beginner riders. Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences exceeding 2' at the same show. Courses to be once or twice around outside lines over 12" cross poles. Trotting not to be penalized.

**Future Rider Section** - open to beginner riders. Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences exceeding 2'3" at the same show. Courses to be once or twice around outside lines over 2' verticals. Trotting not to be penalized.

**Low Children's / AA Section** - open to Children's and Adult Amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences exceeding 2'6" at the same show. Fences 2'3" - no oxers.

**Modified Children's / AA Section** - open to Children's and Adult Amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'9" at the same show. Fences 2'6".

**Children's / AA Section** - open to Children's and Adult Amateur riders. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 2'9".

*Note: Trainers and advanced riders on young horses may enter and show in any of these classes "NOT TO BE JUDGED". Be sure to enter your classes under this notation and tell the starter at the back gate when you walk in the ring if you are not to be judged.*

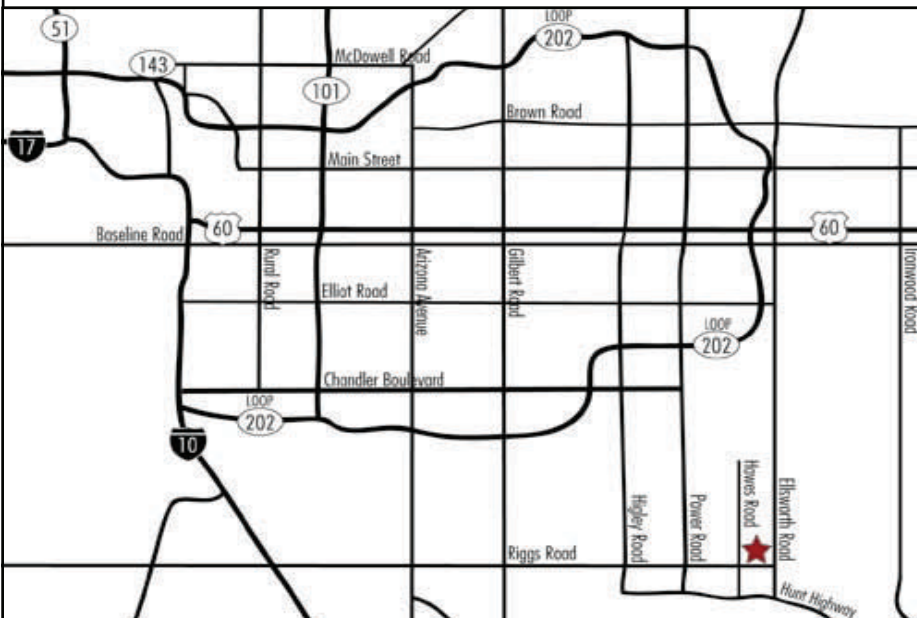
