

## What To Do If You Want To Enter Both Shows

So, you want to enter and compete at both the Estes Park Festival (EPF) and the Copper Penny II (CP II) shows in Estes Park on July 26-30? Here is what you need to know.

- 1) These are two completely different shows that operate under two completely different sets of rules and fees, so you will need to use both entry blanks and fill both of them out completely. Payment must be made to each show separately as well, so plan to submit a deposit check or credit card form for EACH show when entering.
  - a. On the Estes Park Festival entry blank, you must send in the \$100 Registration Fee and \$250 Stall Fee, total of \$350. You can send in a check or the credit card authorization form.
  - b. On the Copper Penny II entry blank, you must send in the \$100 Registration Fee only, total of \$100. You can send in a check or the credit card authorization form.
  - c. So, to recap, if you are entering both shows, you need to fill out both entry blanks and submit with proper deposits for each show (\$350 for EPF and \$100 for CP II), for a grand total of \$450. If either or both entry blanks qualify for the \$50 Good Entry Discount, it will be applied, for a total discount of either \$50 or \$100.
- 2) If you are competing at both shows, you will be responsible for the following fees:
  - a. \$250 Stall Fee - this fee is charged on the EPF entry blank and you only have to pay the stall fee once. Your CP II statement, when you close out, will not reflect any stall charges. If it does, please let the secretaries know so that it can be removed from your bill.
  - b. \$16 USEF Competition Fee and \$7 USHJA Zone Fee - these fees are charged on the EPF entry blank and are mandatory, pass-through fees initiated by the USEF and USHJA. Every entry is required to pay these fees.
  - c. \$30 Show Pass Fees - if you are not a member of the USEF and/or USHJA and you do not intend to join at the show, you will be required to pay a \$30 Show Pass Fee to each organization, for a total of \$60. These fees are charged on the EPF entry blank and are mandatory, pass-through fees initiated by the USEF and the USHJA. If you are a member or join at the show, these fees are waived.
  - d. \$25 Medic Fee - this fee helps offset the cost of medical coverage and is charged separately for each show, so you will need to pay this fee twice, once on each entry blank (separate medics are hired to cover each show, so there are direct costs associated with each show).
  - e. \$250 RV Fee - please complete an RV Reservation Form and submit with your payment by entry closing date. You only need to pay this fee once. Please check the box for EPF on the form. If you do not need an RV space, this fee does not apply.
  - f. \$75 Jumper Nominating Fee - if you compete in any jumper classes at 1.20m or above at the EPF show, you will be charged this fee. There is no need to pay this in advance as it will be added to your account automatically if you enter any eligible classes. If you don't compete in any jumper classes at 1.20m or above, then this fee does not apply.
  - g. \$50 Haul-In Fee - if you haul your horse in and don't use a stall, a \$50 Haul-In Fee will be added to your EPF account instead of a stall fee. This fee will only be charged once.
- 3) Trainer Accounts and Splits - due to the nature of these two shows, separate trainer accounts must be established for each show. Trainers are cautioned that if you have horses showing in both shows, and you wish your trainer account to be split amongst your clients, great care must be taken to properly allocate the correct charges to the correct clients in the correct shows. Please be sure to visit the horse show office by noon on Friday to make sure your trainer account can be satisfactorily taken care of. After this noon on Friday deadline, no splits can be done and all trainer accounts must be paid in full by the trainer.
- 4) Tack Stalls - trainers and exhibitors with horses showing at both shows should reserve tack stalls using the EPF entry blank or the Block Stabling Request by checking EPF on the form.
