FEED & BEDDING NEEDS

Feed and bedding is available from the horse show office during the show. Orders placed by noon on show days will be delivered same day. Orders placed after noon on show days will be delivered next day. All orders must be placed by noon on Saturday, as there are no deliveries on Sunday. All orders can be placed on your horse show account.

For pre-show orders, go to the CEP website and download the Pre-Show Feed & Bedding Order Form. Complete and email back by the deadline dates listed on the form.

RV / CAMPER HOOK-UPS

RV spaces with water and electric are \$350 / week paid in advance, \$400 / week paid at the show (if available). Pump-outs are NOT included. An RV dump station is available on the grounds at no charge for your convenience. You may also arrange for your own pump-out service if you wish. RV reservation forms are available on the CEP website at www.cepshows.com. First-paid, first reserved. RV spaces may not be shared or resold ... canceled reservations will go to the next application in line on the waiting list.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Copper Penny I: Horses may arrive anytime after 10:00am on Monday, July 15th. Early arrival requests must be made via email to entries@cepshows.com and are subject to facility approval. Early arrivals, if available, will be charged \$40 per stall for each night. Horses must depart by 8:00pm on Sunday, July 21st unless staying for the next show.

Copper Penny II: Horses may arrive anytime after 1:00pm on Monday, July 22nd; horses must depart by 8:00am on Monday, July 29th. If the first week is sold out, no early arrivals will be permitted.



ALL ENTRIES MUST NOW BE DONE ONLINE AT HORSESHOWING.COM

Entry closing date is Monday, July 1st, 2024.

Online entries must be submitted by this date to be considered on time. Entries submitted after this date or submitted without the \$100 Registration Fee are considered late and will incur a \$50 Late Fee.

- 1) Go to [www.horseshowing.com](http://www.horseshowing.com), Enter Shows / Click Here To Enter Online
- 2) Log in (or create account if this is your first time)
- 3) Fill out entry / class information as required (horse, owner, trainer, rider, etc.)
- 4) Under Fees, there is already a "1" next to Stall Reservation and Registration Fee. You do not need to change these as you will not be charged for the stall at this time. If you haul-in, you will just pay the Haul-In Fee at checkout.
- 5) You can click on "Notes" if you wish to leave us a note about your entry
- 6) Sign the Entry Agreement ... all signatures are required
- 7) Click on "Save" at the bottom right and confirm if asked
- 8) Click on "Select For Submission"
- 9) The \$100 Registration Fee must accompany your entry and may be done in one of two ways (you do not need to pay for your stall or haul-in at this time):
  - a) If you wish to pay by credit card, click on the "Credit" option and complete the required credit card information. This transaction will be charged immediately upon submission. A non-refundable 3% Convenience Fee will be added to all credit card transactions. There is also a box that you can check that will authorize CEP future use of your card in order to charge your closeout bill on the last day of the show to the same credit card (this way your account is guaranteed and you don't have to provide a card at check-in). If you do not check this box, you will be required to come to the show office on check-in day with a credit card for swiping or to leave a signed, open check on file.
  - b) If you wish to pay by check, click on the "Check" option and submit your entry. Then postal mail a check, payable to CEP, 29455 N Cave Creek Road, Suite 118-430, Cave Creek, AZ 85331. Be sure to write the horse's show name on the memo line (must match the name used on the entry). This check must be received by the entry closing date. Checks received AFTER entry closing date or entries with no check received will result in a \$50 Late Fee. You will then be required to come to the show office on check-in day with a credit card for swiping or to leave a signed, open check on file.
  - c) If there is no form of payment from the owner by the end of the show, the account will be charged to the Trainer's Account.
- 10) Final step ... be sure to click on "Submit" at the bottom right of the page

## SCHOOLING IN THE SHOW RINGS

**Schooling Fee:** All horses entered in each show will be charged a \$25 Schooling Fee. This fee is to help offset the cost of schooling and warming up in the rings on Tuesdays, hacking in the jumper ring on show days and any schooling over fences in the hunter rings and Ring 3 on show days. This fee is mandatory whether you school or not.

**Hunter Rings & Ring 3:** Open schooling is permitted on warm-up days (Tuesdays) in the Hunter Rings from 10:00am to 5:00pm and in Ring 3 from 12:00pm to 5:00pm. Each show morning, these rings are open for schooling before their start time (see Daily Schedule for times when each ring closes and any exceptions). Each afternoon, rings may be open for schooling after being rebuilt, time and weather / footing conditions permitting.

**Jumper Ring:** Open on both Tuesdays for open schooling from 9:00am to 4:00pm. Jumps may be adjusted and no set schedule or heights are in place. No other schooling over fences in the jumper ring is scheduled during the shows. Hacking only will be allowed each show morning up until one hour before the start of classes. Hacking only may be permitted each afternoon, by request, after the ring is built, time and weather / footing conditions permitting.

Championships will be awarded in each section with all classes counting equally. Points awarded 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2. If there is a tie for champion or reserve, the tie will be broken: 1) most points over fences; 2) Eq Flat class placing; 3) Hunter U/S class placing. If there is a tie for champion or reserve in the jumper sections, entries will remain tied and all get appropriate awards. Horses must have competed in at least two other classes in the same jumper section to be eligible for the OR 0.70m Jumper Stake class.

## 2024 COPPER PENNY HORSE SHOWS \*\* INDEX TO CLASSES

**ALL 400 SERIES WARM-UP CLASSES:** Enter by individual class numbers on the schedule. Entry Fee: \$25 per class

To be held open during each set of classes with concurrent heights (see schedule). Hunter and Equitation warm-up classes to be run as a Blue / Red with scores of 85 and above receiving a Blue ribbon and scores of 75-84 receiving a Red ribbon. Scores below 75 will not receive a ribbon. Warm-Up classes held before equitation classes will allow equitation tack and attire. Jumper Warm-Up classes will allow jumper tack and attire and will be scored under Table II Clear Round. All warm-up classes are open to any horse and rider except for Pony warm-ups, which are limited to ponies ridden by a junior rider. You may compete in these classes as many times as you wish (you may also enter at the gate as long as the ring is not full and declared closed) but you must follow the order of the classes on the schedule ... once you compete in the next class (the first recognized class after a warm-up), you may not go back and do another warm-up round of the same class number.

### SPECIAL CLASSES

*Deadline for entries into these Special Classes is 5:00pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is scheduled to be held. Entries after this time, if accepted, will pay a \$25 Post Entry Fee and go first in the order. Scratches out of these Special Classes must be conducted in the horse show office by 5:00pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is scheduled to be held. Scratches after this time will forfeit the entry fee unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch. Any exceptions to this are listed with the class. Special classes with less than eight entries at 5:00pm the day before may be canceled or combined at management's discretion.*

#### **501. \$5000 CHJA MINI PRIX - Entry Fee: \$175**

Open to any horse / rider combination. To be eligible, horses must have competed in at least one other jumper class at this show. Fences 1.00m to 1.10m. Table II; Sec 2a. Prize money divided \$1500, \$1100, \$750, \$500, \$350, \$300, \$250, \$250. Same day scratches up until the start of the class will be allowed and will be subject to a \$50 Scratch Fee.

#### **502. \$2500 CHJA PRO / AM HUNTER DERBY - Entry Fee: \$125**

To be eligible, horses must have competed in at least two hunter classes over fences at this show (warm-up classes do not qualify). This will be a two-round class. One round must be ridden by a professional and the other round must be ridden by a junior or amateur. In the first round, entries must jump a typical hunter classic style course. The second round will be over a hunter handy style course. Either rider may do either course, but the switch of riders after the first round must take place in a designated change box in the arena. One groom may assist in the switch, as a change of saddle will be permitted. The switch must not exceed 60 seconds in duration. Communication between riders will be permitted. If the 60 second clock expires prior to the horse exiting the change box, one point per full second over will be deducted from the overall score. An official time keeper will be in the box monitoring the time and letting the entry know when their time is about to lapse. Open numerical scoring system with two judges sitting together and throwing one score. Trainers may compete on multiple teams on different horses; juniors and amateurs may only compete once. Fences 2'9". Prize money divided \$750, \$550, \$375, \$250, \$175, \$150, \$125, \$125. Same day scratches up until the start of the class will be allowed and will be subject to a \$25 Scratch Fee.

#### **503. \$500 STIRRUP CUP HUNTER DERBY - Entry Fee: \$50**

To be eligible, horse / rider combinations must have competed in at least two classes over fences in the Short, Medium or Long Stirrup Hunter section at the same show. To be shown over a first round hunter classic course of at least 9 fences. The top twelve scoring entries will return, in reverse order of score from the first round, for a second round handy course of at least 8 fences. Open numerical scoring. Scores from both rounds to be totaled to determine the winner. Fences 2'3" no oxers. Prize money divided \$150, \$100, \$75, \$65, \$60, \$50.

#### **504. \$500 ADDED GAMBLER'S CHOICE - Entry Fee: \$75**

To be eligible, horses must have competed in at least two other jumper classes at the same show. In this competition, there will be 10 obstacles set in the arena. Each obstacle carries a value from 10 points to 100 points. Obstacles will be built so that they may be jumped in both directions. After the starting tone, the competitor must cross the start line in either direction to start their time. They must then jump the obstacles, in either direction, a maximum of two times each, with the goal being to accumulate the highest point total. Disobediences are not penalized except for time taken. If an obstacle is knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped after being knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped a third time, no points will be awarded. When the 60 seconds has expired, a tone will sound and the competitor must cross the finish line to stop their time. At the conclusion of the round, and after their score has been announced, a tone will sound again and the competitor will have 30 seconds to attempt the Joker Jump. If jumped successfully, an additional 200 points will be added to their score. If a disobedience or knockdown occurs, 200 points will be deducted from their score. Only one attempt is allowed. The winner will have the highest point total in the fastest time. Fences 0.85m to 1.10m (Joker to be higher). \$25 of each entry will be added back to the \$500 purse. Prize money divided eight places 30%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 8%, 7%, 5%, 5%.

#### **505. LEADLINE 12 & UNDER - No Entry Fee (offered both weeks)**

#### **506. LEADLINE ADULT - No Entry Fee (offered the first week only)**

Open to very beginner riders 12 years of age or younger and adults (parents, family or friends of riders). Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same show. To be led around the ring at the walk. Judge may ask questions of the riders. Proper hardhat and footwear with a heel are required.

#### **507. EGG & SPOON CLASS - No Entry Fee**

Open to any horse and rider. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring holding a spoon with an egg on it. Judges may ask for any other tests on the flat. Winner is the last rider to still have their egg.

#### **508. SIT-A-BUCK CLASS - No Entry Fee**

Open to any horse and rider. Riders will enter the ring carrying their own dollar bill and line-up in the middle, where they will place their dollar bill under their upper leg with at least 50% of it showing. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Judges may ask for any other tests on the flat. Winner is the last rider or riders to still have their dollar bill. Winners split all the dollar bills dropped.

### 509. CHAMPAGNE GLASS CLASS - No Entry Fee

Open to any horse and rider. Riders will enter the ring and line-up in the middle, where they will be given a plastic champagne glass with either champagne or cider if the rider is a junior. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Judges may ask for any other tests on the flat. Then riders will be asked to line-up in the middle and present their glasses for inspection. Winner is the rider with the most liquid left in their glass.

### 513. \$750 CHJA LOW CHILDREN'S / ADULT HUNTER CLASSIC 2'9" - Entry Fee: \$60

### 514. \$1000 CHJA CHILDREN'S / ADULT HUNTER CLASSIC 3'0" - Entry Fee: \$75

To be eligible, horse / rider combinations must have competed in all of the qualifying classes (regular hunter classes) over fences in their respective sections (CHJA Short, CHJA Medium or CHJA Long Stirrup Hunter; CHJA Mod Children's / Adult, CHJA Low Children's or CHJA Low Adult Hunter; CHJA Children's or CHJA Adult Hunter) at this show (warm-up classes do not qualify). The last round of each qualifying section counts as the first round of this classic. All entries shall return for a second round over at least eight fences. Open numerical scoring. Scores from both rounds to be totaled to determine the winner. Fence heights as specified. \$500 prize money divided \$150, \$110, \$75, \$60, \$55, \$50. \$750 prize money divided \$225, \$165, \$110, \$95, \$80, \$75. \$1000 prize money divided \$300, \$220, \$150, \$100, \$70, \$60, \$50, \$50. BONUS: If you show in all of the qualifying classes at both Copper Penny shows, your entry fee into these classes will be FREE!

### 515. \$500 0.80m MINI CHJA JUMPER DERBY - Entry Fee: \$50

### 516. \$1000 0.90m LOW CHJA JUMPER DERBY - Entry Fee: \$75

### 517. \$2000 1.00m HIGH CHJA JUMPER DERBY - Entry Fee: \$125

To be eligible, horses must have shown in at least two qualifying classes (regular jumper classes) at height (0.70m, 0.75m or 0.85m for the Mini Jumper Derby; 0.85m, 0.90m or 1.00m for the Low Jumper Derby; 1.00m, 1.10m or 1.15m for the High Jumper Derby) at the same show (warm-up classes do not qualify). Entries may enter and compete in two derbies if eligible (consecutive fence heights, meaning the same horse and rider combination may not enter the Mini and the High). To be shown over at least 14 fences at specified height. The first two refusals will be penalized by time taken and the third refusal shall incur elimination. Each knockdown will incur a four second penalty added to the final time. The winner is the entry with the fastest final time. Management reserves the right to combine classes if any have less than eight (8) entries. \$500 prize money divided \$150, \$110, \$75, \$50, \$35, \$30, \$25, \$25. \$1000 prize money divided \$300, \$220, \$150, \$100, \$70, \$60, \$50, \$50. \$2000 prize money divided \$600, \$440, \$300, \$200, \$140, \$120, \$100, \$100. BONUS: If you show in at least two of the eligible qualifying classes at both Copper Penny shows, your entry fee into these classes will be FREE!

### 518. THE EPIC RIDE-AND-DRIVE EVENT - No Entry Fee

Riders will jump a short course of fences at 2'6" in height. After jumping the last fence, riders will ride into a designated area and dismount, handing their horse to a helper. They will then get on or in a golf cart driven by a team mate (driver must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license issued by a state government ... a learner's permit is not acceptable) and negotiate a course of obstacles. Knocking any rails down or tennis balls off cones will incur a time penalty of 5 seconds each. The winner is the team crossing the finish line in the fastest overall time. Teams must provide their own golf carts.

### 519. \$250 ALL STIRRUP EQUITATION CLASSIC - Entry Fee: \$35

To be eligible, riders must have competed in at least one class over fences in the CHJA Short, CHJA Medium or CHJA Long Stirrup Equitation section at the same show. To be shown over an equitation course of at least 8 fences. Fences 2'3" with no oxers. The top twelve scoring entries will return for a flat phase. Ribbons first through eighth. First, second and third places receive gift certificates for \$125, \$75 and \$50.

### 520. \$500 EQUITATION FLAT CLASSIC - Entry Fee: \$40

Open to any junior or amateur rider. To be eligible, riders must have competed in at least one other equitation class, over fences or on the flat, at the same show (warm-up classes do not qualify). To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked for any number of tests on the flat. No jumping. Entries will be brought to the middle one at a time until only the winner remains on the rail. Great prizes and gift certificates to the top three (gift certificates in the amount of \$250, \$150, \$100).

### 521. \$500 OPEN UNDER SADDLE DERBY - Entry Fee: \$40

Open to any horse and rider combination. To be eligible, horses must have shown in at least one other hunter class, over fences or under saddle, at the same show (warm-up classes do not qualify). To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Entries may be asked to hand gallop, but never more than eight at a time. Entries will be brought to the middle one at a time until only the winner remains on the rail. Prize money divided \$250, \$150, \$100 to the top three.

### 522. ESTES TEAM JUMPER RELAY 0.60m / 0.75m / 0.90m - Entry Fee: \$10 per team member

This class will consist of teams of three riders comprised of professionals, juniors and amateurs, however, no team may have more than one professional. Professionals may compete on more than one team as long as they ride a different horse on each team they are on. Horses and junior / amateur riders may only compete on one team. Teams will enter the ring and position themselves anywhere they would like. The designated 0.60m rider will be handed the baton as they enter the ring. When the tone sounds, the first rider must pass through the start line to begin their time and jump fences numbered 1 through 4 set at 0.60m. After jumping fence #4, the first rider must pass the baton to the second rider, who will then jump fences numbered 5 through 8 set at 0.75m. After jumping fence #8, the second rider must pass the baton to the third rider, who will then jump fences numbered 9 through 12 set at 0.90m, then pass through the finish line to stop their time. Faults will be incurred as under Table II; Section 1 except the first two cumulative refusals will not be penalized except for time taken. A third cumulative refusal will result in elimination. Any fall will also result in elimination. If the baton is dropped at any time, any team member may dismount, pick it up, hand it back to the rider and remount. No others may assist in picking up a dropped baton. A maximum of twenty teams will be allowed. Entries for this class will close either at 5:00pm the day before or when twenty teams have entered the class, whichever comes first. When entering, each entry must enter the class normally on their entry blanks or add / scratch form, plus fill out the team declaration form. Theme song requests will only be honored if teams are entered by 5:00pm Thursday ... late entries will have a song chosen by the judge. Team names and theme songs must be appropriate for all ages. Costumes are encouraged (not required) and a special award will be presented to the team with the best costume. Proper hard hats and heels are required. Entry Fee is \$10 per team member (\$30 per team).

# The Second Annual CHJA Team Jumper Championships

**Class 531. \$500 0.80m CHJA Team Jumper Championship**

**Class 532. \$1000 0.90m CHJA Team Jumper Championship**

**Class 533. \$2000 1.00m CHJA Team Jumper Championship**

*~ These classes are offered during the first week only, CHJA Copper Penny I ~*

To be eligible, horses must have competed in at least two classes at a qualifying height during the show. Horses and riders may only compete in one championship. Qualifying heights are:

For the 0.80m Championship – 0.70m, 0.75m, 0.85m

For the 0.90m Championship – 0.85m, 0.90m, 1.00m

For the 1.00m Championship – 0.90m, 1.00m, 1.10m, 1.15m

Entries will close at 5:00pm the day before the classes are held – NO EXCEPTIONS. Due to the complexities of establishing an order of go by team and then designating an order by team members, no entries will be accepted after 5:00pm the day before or on the same day.

There will be three separate competitions, one at each height of 0.80m, 0.90m and 1.00m. Teams may consist of three or four members. Teams with three members will have all three scores count. Teams with four members will drop their low score. To be run under a modified Nation's Cup format.

When entering, teams must complete a separate entry form that declares the three or four entries and the order that the riders will compete within their own team. By 6:00pm the day before, the order of go by team and rider will be established and published at the office and online.

All entries will jump a first round course of at least 12 fences at the appropriate height. After all entries have gone, team scores will be tallied. A team score shall consist of total jumping faults and the total time taken on course by the top three riders (teams of three will have all rider's scores count; teams of four may drop their low score). The top four teams with the least amount of faults in the fastest total time will return, in reverse order, for a second round of at least 10 fences. If there is a tie among teams for the least amount of faults, then the total time taken by each team shall break the tie.

After all entries have jumped a second round, if there is a tie for first place only with equal faults, tied teams must designate a single rider to represent them in a jump-off against the clock. If there is a jump-off, scores from the first two rounds are discarded and the jump-off becomes the single tie-breaking criteria. The order for the jump-off will be determined by the total time taken in the first two rounds by each team. Ties for other than first place will be decided by total time taken over the two rounds by the tied teams.

In the event a team of four members loses one of their members after the start of the first round (withdraws before competing), the remaining three members may continue to compete with all three scores being counted. In the event a team of three members loses one of their members in the first round after the start of the class, the remaining team members may continue to compete in the first round but may not continue to the second round and will be disqualified. In the event a team of three members loses one of their members in the second round, the remaining team members may continue to compete in the second round but will receive a team score of Zero "0" and will be placed last of the four teams in the second round.

A presentation ceremony will be held for the top three teams for each height. Riders must stand with their team members and grooms may hold the horses behind the line-up. Prize money divided to the top three teams 50%, 30%, 20%. Entry Fee: \$60 per team.

Proper attire and tack required. While you should plan on a team name, this is not a costume class so please do not wear costumes.

# 2024 COPPER PENNY HORSE SHOWS \*\* RULES & REGULATIONS

## CONDITION OF ENTRY

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management, their decision to be final. Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in classes, or make any changes management deems in the best interests of the show.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the show, CHJA, CEP, its members, directors and employees, the Town of Estes Park and the Estes Park Events Complex harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

**SHOW SCRATCH (a horse entered but scratched from the entire show prior to going in any classes) - 1)** on or before the closing date of entries, all fees shall be refunded; **2)** after the closing date of entries but prior to arrival on the grounds, the \$100 Registration Fee is not refundable and is forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee; **3)** after arrival on the grounds but prior to showing in any classes, the stall fee and \$100 Registration Fee is not refundable and is forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee. All show scratches must be submitted in writing before the end of the show.

**ADDING REGULAR CLASSES:** If you wish to add a regular class after initially checking in and picking up your number, you must do so by 5pm the day before the class is to be held and you must add it on an Add / Scratch Form or Trainer Sheet. Adds after 5pm or same day adds will only be allowed if the schedule in that ring is not full. Same day adds **MUST** be done on an Add / Scratch Form, **NOT** a Trainer Sheet, and **MUST** be given to the starter **BEFORE** the start of the class that was added. In any case, there is no charge to add a regular class.

**SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES:** If you do not intend to show in a regular class you have entered, you **MUST** scratch it on an Add / Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the horse show office before the class begins. There will be no charge for this. Scratches may not be done after a class has started. Telling the starter at the back gate that you are not going or simply not showing up will result in forfeiture of the entry fee. **STARTERS DO NOT HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO SCRATCH YOU FROM A CLASS.**

**STALLS / HAUL-IN FEE -** Stalls are \$250 each week. If a horse competes both weeks, it can get a stall for \$125 the second week. Day Stalls and Pro-Rated stalls are not available. Haul-ins (no stall) must pay a \$50 weekly fee. All horses must pay either a Stall Fee or Haul-In Fee. Group stabling is available by visiting the CEP website at [www.cepshows.com](http://www.cepshows.com), downloading a Block Stabling Request and submitting it.

**TRAINER SPLITS -** As a courtesy, the show will split a trainer's account amongst all of the clients. See office for filing deadlines. If any of the trainer's clients have already checked out by that time, the split will not include them.

**ATTIRE / EQUIPMENT -** Proper basic show attire for the rider includes boots / jodhpur boots and britches and collared shirts (hunt coats optional). USEF rules will be followed for equipment for the horse. In any case, footwear with at least a 1/2" heel is required. A proper hard hat is mandatory for all riders while mounted. Martingales are prohibited in all under saddle and pleasure classes. All other questions regarding tack and equipment shall be at the sole discretion of the judge and/or show management, their decision to be final.

**FOOD CONCESSION -** Limited food and beverage available at the Fairgrounds. Hours as posted by Vendor.

**RETURNED CHECKS -** A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$25)! Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the proper authorities for prosecution.

**FEED AND BEDDING -** Feed and bedding may be ordered from the horse show office and placed on your horse show account. Orders placed by noon will be delivered the same day. Orders placed after noon will be delivered the following day. Exception: no orders can be placed after noon on Saturday or anytime on Sunday, as the off-site retailer will be closed. For Pre-Orders, visit the CEP website at [www.cepshows.com](http://www.cepshows.com) and download the Feed & Bedding Form. **SHAVINGS MUST BE PURCHASED FROM THE ON-SITE FEED RETAILER AT THE FACILITY. OUTSIDE SHAVINGS MAY NOT BE BROUGHT ONTO THE GROUNDS OR DELIVERED TO YOUR STALLS.**

**DAMAGE -** Trainers and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees, to buildings or other property, and shall be billed accordingly.

**DOGS -** Must be kept on a leash at all times anywhere on the show grounds. Horse show management may fine individuals whose dogs are loose up to \$50 for each occurrence and this amount will be added to your account. Animal Control may be called for repeat violators..

**SPLITTING / COMBINING CLASSES -** If the first class of a section has 20 or more entries that compete, it will be California split and all remaining classes in the same section will also be California split, regardless of the number of entries that compete in them. In this case, if a championship is awarded, there will be two champions and two reserve champions. If the first class of a section has less than 20 entries that compete, it will not be split and neither will any of the remaining classes in the section regardless of the number of entries that compete in them. Individual classes with 20 or more entries that compete will be California split (exception: warm-up and Special classes will not be split). Classes with less than the required minimums will be combined, if possible, or canceled, if necessary.

**GOLF CARTS -** Golf-N-Fun Cars is the official golf cart concessionaire of the Copper Penny Horse Shows. Golf carts **must be reserved and paid for in advance** by calling them at 970-218-5516. No carts will be available on the grounds for rental.

**MEDICAL COVERAGE FEE -** A \$25 Medic Fee will be charged to every horse each week to help offset the cost of on-site medical coverage, equipment use and supplies.

**SCHOOLING FEE -** All horses entered in each show will be charged a \$25 Schooling Fee. This fee is to help offset the cost of schooling and warming up in the rings on Tuesdays, hacking in the jumper ring on show days and any schooling over fences in the hunter rings and Ring 3 on show days. This fee is mandatory whether you school or not.


**CREDIT CARD USE -** A 3% Convenience Fee will be charged for all credit card transactions. Since this fee goes directly to the merchant account company for every transaction, once charged it is non-refundable and non-creditable under any circumstances.

Preference for stabling in the Pavilion Barn is given to those trainers that are showing both weeks and experience little to no changes in stall counts between the two weeks. The facility will not strip out stalls between shows, due to there being horses in the building and the resulting dust cloud and loud noises associated with heavy equipment use are liabilities. So those that request the Pavilion stalls must show both weeks and have identical or very similar numbers, and be among the first entries received for the shows.

The policy for the RV reservations is similar ... preference is given to those that are staying both weeks. After enough reservations are received to sell out all spaces, those staying both weeks are prioritized over those only reserving one week. There is no guarantee that an RV reserving both weeks will be accepted, but those reservations are prioritized over one week reservations. Once sold out, a waiting list will be started.

## Ring Scheduling, Same Day Adds & Cancellation / Combining of Classes

At 5:00pm every day, including warm-up / check-in day, the office stops accepting entries for the next day. After all entries are input into the computer, a schedule including class counts and class start / finish times is created for the next show day and will be available outside the office and online at the cepshows.com website by 6:00pm. This schedule shows each ring, how many entries are in each class, and what time each class, or group of classes, is scheduled to start. Remember, these times are approximate, and may vary slightly, but are designed to give you a general idea of when your classes will go. This way, you don't have to show up at 7:00am and just sit around until 11:00am for your class! Go have breakfast, get in a round of golf or catch the sunrise as it comes over the mountains.

Adding regular classes after 5:00pm for the next day, or adding regular classes the same day they are being held, is allowed as long as the schedule is not full in a particular ring. If the following day's schedule in a ring is full at 5:00pm the day before, then that ring is declared "closed" and will not allow same day adds. Trainers and exhibitors are urged to stop by the office before 5:00pm each day to verify their entries for the next day. This way, adds can be made before the 5:00pm deadline, and you are assured of getting into your classes.

At 5:00pm each day, when the final numbers are compiled and the schedule for the next day is created, management will make decisions about classes with less than the entry minimums. These classes are either canceled or combined with other classes, if possible. The class sheets are printed and judge's cards finalized. This next sentence is very important ... **any classes canceled or combined WILL NOT BE UNCANCELED OR UNCOMBINED, regardless of how many entries actually show or wish to show in them.** This is a firm policy and the only way to maintain reasonable control over a schedule that, if allowed to change in that manner, could push things back by hours. So be sure you are entered in all your desired classes by 5:00pm the day before. If the schedule fills up and the ring is declared 'closed', you won't be able to add into it.
