

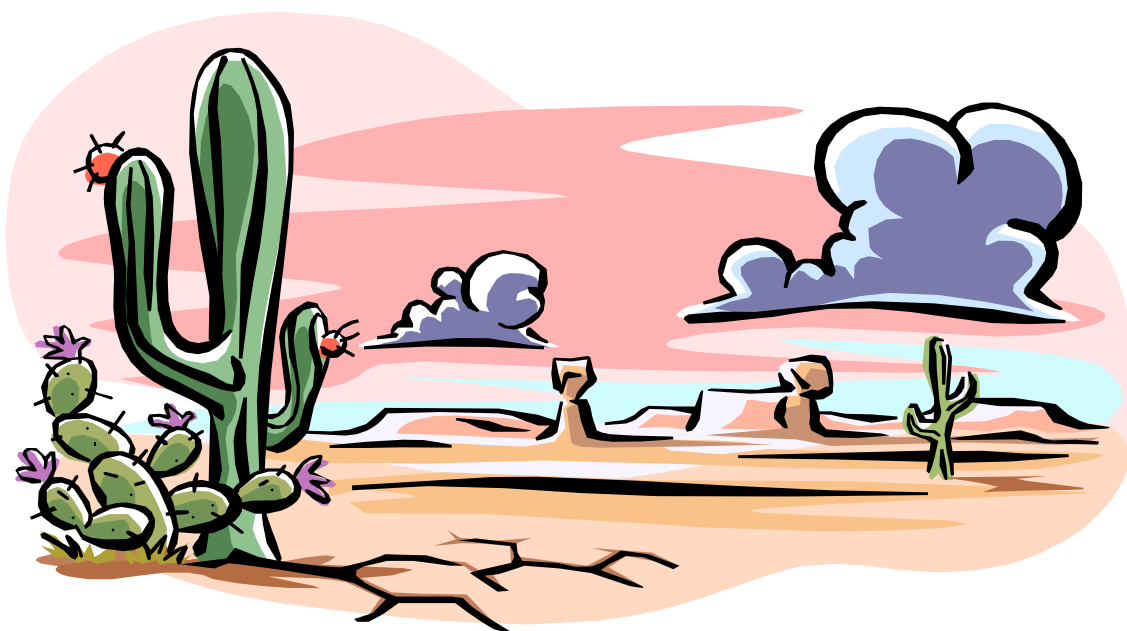

CEP Shows Joins USHJA Outreach Program In 2023



What exactly does this mean for you?

If you show in any of the following, they will now be conducted under the USHJA's Outreach Program:
(Sections include both hunter and equitation classes; professionals can compete on young horses Hors Concours in any of these classes)

- OR Walk-Trot Poles Section 4"
- OR Crossrail Section 12"
- OR Future Rider Section 18"
- OR Short Stirrup 17&U Section 2'0"
- OR Long Stirrup 18&O Section 2'0"
- OR Beginner Rider Section 2'3"
- OR Low Children's Section 2'6"
- OR Low Adult Section 2'6"
- OR Mod Child / Adult Section 2'9"
- 0.70m OR Jumper
- 0.80m OR Jumper
- 0.90m OR Jumper
- CEP Hunter Derby 2' to 2'9"
- CEP Equitation Challenge 2' to 2'9"

You are still competing in a regular USEF-licensed National (A) or Regional (B) show, but these classes are now being conducted under the USHJA's Outreach Program. This means:

- 1) Horses do not need to be registered, recorded or have a microchip
- 2) Riders, trainers and owners do not need to be a member of the USEF or USHJA and there are no Non Member or Show Pass fees
- 3) Entries do not have to pay the \$23 USEF Fee
- 4) And the best part ... entry fees for classes listed above are only \$25 or \$30 per class and stall fees are reduced



Trainers on young horses looking for mileage can show Hors Concours ... if you currently go to local schooling shows and want to move up to a higher level competition ... if you've never shown at a USEF show and just want to try it for the first time ... if you're a show ring veteran and want an alternative to the high prices and mandatory USEF requirements ... if you just want to show your horse and you don't care about Zone or National year-end awards or qualifying ... then these USHJA Outreach classes are for you!

If you are interested in earning points and recognition as a USHJA Outreach member, you can participate in the optional USHJA Outreach Awards & Rewards Program

- Trainers - join the USHJA and earn the USHJA Outreach High Point Trainer Award by being the leading trainer in your zone whose riders have earned the highest USHJA Outreach Class Points.
- Riders - join the USHJA with a free Outreach-level membership to accrue equitation points within your zone. In addition, you can become eligible for the chance to be a high point rider from your Zone and earn a Golden Backstage Pass to participate in the USHJA National Championship and get exclusive access to free educational sessions and National Championship Grand Prix and Hunter Derby course walks!
- Horses / Owners - Owners wishing for their horses to earn points must have them recorded with USHJA (\$20/annual or \$75/lifetime). Horses will then have their Outreach points tracked and ranked within their USHJA Zone and displayed on ushja.org.

EQUINE HEALTH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

CEP Scottsdale Horse Shows - Scottsdale, AZ



USEF requirements, combined with existing facility policies, are designed to protect your horse and other horses participating in any CEP show at the Westworld Equestrian Center in Scottsdale, Arizona. These measures are designed to decrease the risk of introduction of or the spread of contagious or infectious disease at its shows.

Horses may only arrive between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm daily. Arrivals at any other time must be approved in advance by emailing CEP at cepshows@aol.com or calling, 480-704-3981, at least 72 hours prior to arrival.

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**UPON YOUR ARRIVAL, YOU MUST PRESENT A COMPLETED
“EQUINE HEALTH DOCUMENT” PRIOR TO UNLOADING YOUR HORSES.
THIS SIMPLIFIED, SINGLE-PAGE DOCUMENT ATTESTS TO THE FOLLOWING:**

HORSE HEALTH VERIFICATION (required by show management)

Verifies that the horse(s) on your trailer have been healthy with no sign of infectious disease and have not had a temperature above 101.5°F within 72 hours of arrival, nor have been around any horses or at any barn or facility that had any horses that were sick or under any type of quarantine within 30 days of arrival. This is required for all horses entering the show grounds whether showing or not.

PROOF OF VACCINATION (required by USEF)

Attests to the fact that you are in possession of (and must be shown upon request) a signed statement or vaccination record from a veterinarian that the horse(s) have been vaccinated against:

Equine Influenza (EIV) within 6 months of the first show day

Rhinopneumonitis (EHV 1 and EHV 4) within 6 months of the first show day

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for the next show.

NEGATIVE COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATE (required by Westworld and/or State of Arizona)

Attests to the fact that all horses arriving onto Westworld property, regardless of where they reside, must provide:

Negative Coggins for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) dated within 12 months of the first show day

In addition, if your horse resides outside of the state and is traveling into Arizona for these shows, it must have:

A Health Certificate dated within 30 days of the first show day

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YOU MUST COMPLETE AND PRESENT THE EQUINE HEALTH DOCUMENT UPON FIRST ARRIVAL (available at the CEP website at www.cepshows.com/horseshows/Arizona). All other documents listed above must be presented only if requested. If you are unable to provide any of these documents upon request, you will be directed to the Show Veterinarian to obtain the required documents and/or vaccinations, at your own expense, and/or be placed in quarantined stabling, at your cost, until the proper documents are obtained. Any horse showing signs of fever / illness / stress is subject to examination by horse show officials and/or the horse show veterinarian, who may, at their sole discretion, place the horse in quarantined stabling or take further action if deemed necessary.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Arrival after 12:00pm on Monday, April 3rd

Departure by 6:00am on Sunday, April 9th

Due to Equine Health Requirements, arrivals on all other days must take place between the hours of 8:00am and 6:00pm

SCHOOLING IN THE SHOW RINGS

All horses entered in the show will be charged a one-time \$25 Schooling Fee. This fee is mandatory and helps to offset the cost of ring rentals, jumps and staffing on warm-up and show days. No refunds if your horse does not school.

Jumper: There is no longer a need to enter a warm-up class in the office. Simply go to the ring when your desired height is running and get on the list to school. Schooling times on warm-up day (Tuesday) are as follows:

1.00m - 10:00am to 11:00am

0.90m - 11:00am to 12:00pm

0.80m - 12:30pm to 2:00pm

0.70m - 2:30pm to 4:00pm

Free hacking only from 4:00pm to 5:00pm

Jump heights may not be adjusted. Multiple riders will be allowed at the same time. No other schooling over fences will be permitted.

Hunter Rings: Schooling is permitted on warm-up day and in the morning of show days as per the published schedule. Each afternoon, hunter rings may be open for schooling at management's discretion and time and weather permitting. Exception: rings may be closed early in the afternoon and / or the following morning if a special class is being held (derby, medal final, etc) and the course is set for it.

Entries must be received by CEP by the entry closing date and must have complete credit card information listed to pay for the Registration & Stall Fees.

***** IMPORTANT ENTRY REMINDER *****

If you are showing in USEF classes only, use the 'USEF' Entry Blank and submit Registration Fee and Stall Fee.

If you are showing in USHJA Outreach classes only, use the 'OR' Entry Blank and submit the Registration Fee and appropriate Stall Fee (\$275, \$175 or other).

If you are showing in both USEF and USHJA Outreach classes, use both entry blanks, listing USEF classes on the 'USEF' Entry Blank and Outreach classes on the 'OR' Entry Blank. In this case, only submit the Registration Fee and Stall Fee from the 'USEF' Entry Blank, not from both.

WARM-UP CLASSES All 900 series class numbers Entry Fee: \$40 each

HUNTER: Entries will be judged but no scores or ribbons will be awarded. JUMPER: To be held open during each set of classes with concurrent heights. Run under USEF Table II, Clear Round, but no ribbons will be awarded. If a ring's schedule is full and the ring is closed to same day adds, only those entered by 5:00pm the night before may compete in these classes. Management reserves the right to cancel warm-up classes entirely if the schedule warrants. If a ring's schedule is not full and is open to same day adds, entries may compete in these classes as many times as they wish. You may even add warm-up rounds at the gate. Warm-Up rounds may be ridden at any time while the card is open. You may do warm-up rounds before, during or after your regular classes. Warm-up rounds may be ridden by any rider, including professionals (exception: for Pony and Children's Pony warm-ups, riders must be eligible to compete on a pony and all USEF rules regarding riders and ponies will apply).

USEF CLASSICS & SPECIAL CLASSES

Entries into any Special Classes should be made by 5:00pm or when the office closes, whichever comes first, the day before it is offered. Entries after this time, if accepted, will pay a Post Entry Fee (\$25 unless otherwise specified) and must go first in the order. Scratches from Special Classes must be conducted in the horse show office by 5:00pm or when the office closes, whichever comes first, the day before the class is offered. Scratches after this time will forfeit the entry fee (unless noted otherwise) unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch. Unless otherwise specified, classes with less than six entries at 5:00pm or when the office closes, whichever comes first, the day before will be canceled or combined at management's discretion. Once canceled or combined, classes will not be uncanceled or uncombined under any circumstances. If a class fills at 5:00pm or when the office closes, whichever comes first, the day before it is offered, but has scratches that leave less than the minimum required prior to its start, management will cancel or combine it as necessary. NOTE: USEF rules require at least six entries in all hunter classics, standalone or combined, in order to be held and count for points. Any hunter classic with less than six entries will be combined if possible, run by itself for no points if not possible or canceled. The USHJA National Hunter Derby requires a minimum of twelve (12) entries and will not go with less.

501. \$2500 USHJA NATIONAL HUNTER DERBY — Hunt & Go Format

Entry Fee: \$175 + \$25 USHJA Fee

Entry deadline is 5:00pm the day preceding the class. The order of go will then be drawn. Entries made after this deadline, if accepted, will be charged a \$25 Post Entry Fee and will be required to go first in the order. Scratches at any time up until the start of the class will be allowed and will receive a refund of the Entry Fee minus a \$50 Scratch Fee. Open to any horse / rider combination. Riders, owners and trainers must be current active members of the USHJA and USEF and horses must be registered with the USHJA prior to the start of the class. Horses must have competed in at least two other hunter classes over fences, prior to or after, at the same show. Failure to do so will result in disqualification with all earnings forfeited. Riders may show as many horses as they wish in this class. Formal attire requested. Proper attire required. Winners to ride for awards. Trophy and Ribbon to 1st Place - Ribbons and prize money awarded through 12th Place. \$2,500 Prize Money divided as follows: 30%, 22%, 13%, 8%, 6%, 5%, 4%, 3%, 3%, 2%, 2%, 2%. Special awards for highest placing Professional, Junior and Amateur riders. If there are less than twelve (12) entries at the entry deadline for the class or at anytime up to the start of the class, the class will be canceled.

502. \$2500 1.20m VARIABLE JUMPER CLASSIC

Entry Fee: \$175

Open to any horse. Horses must have competed in at least one other jumper class at this show. Horses must pay the Jumper Nominating Fee in order to enter this class. Fences 1.20m (3'11"). Table II; Sec 2.2b (Time First Jump-Off). Prize money divided \$625, \$400, \$325, \$300, \$250, \$225, \$200, \$175. If there are 12 or more entries at the start of the class, full prize money will apply. 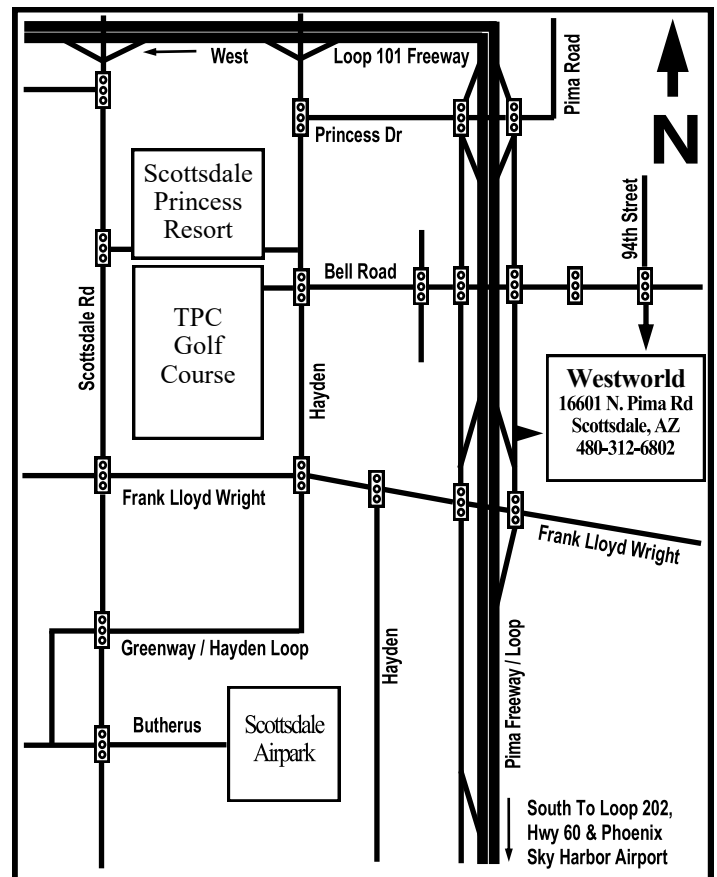

IMPORTANT POLICIES OF THE HORSE SHOW

Class Adds & Scratches, Same Day Class Adds

All entries for the next day, including adds and scratches, must be made by 5:00pm or the close of the office, whichever comes first, each day. This allows the next day's schedule to be created, with class counts and times, and made available to everyone by 6:00pm. Any changes made after this deadline, if accepted, will be considered SAME DAY and will fall under the SAME DAY policy. CEP allows same-day adds as long as the schedule in each ring is not full. If the following day's schedule in a ring is full at 5:00pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before, then that ring is declared "closed" and will not allow same day adds. To keep from getting shut out of classes, exhibitors are urged to verify their entries for the next day prior to close of office.

Canceling And Combining Of Classes

At 5:00pm each day, the schedule for the next day is created. Classes with less than the entry minimums are either canceled or combined with other classes, if possible. Then the schedule is published, the class sheets are printed and judge's cards finalized. Please note that any classes canceled or combined WILL NOT BE UNCANCELED OR UNCOMBINED, regardless of how many entries actually show or wish to show in them. So be sure you are entered in all your desired classes by 5:00pm or close of office the day before.

Scratch Your Classes BEFORE They Start

Be sure to scratch any classes you have entered that you won't be showing in BEFORE the classes start in the horse show office. If you don't scratch them at all, try to scratch them after they have started or simply tell the starter you're not going in them, there is no refund. To maintain an accurate schedule for the competitors, we need to know if you plan to show or not.

Ring Scheduling

Each ring will also be run according to a time schedule, with start and finish times established for each section or class. These times will be strictly adhered to. Starters will have little or no leeway in remaining open past their scheduled finish times, so please don't put them or yourself in an awkward position by asking a ring to remain open past its scheduled finish time.

Non-Showing Horses

Non-showing horses are permitted at all CEP shows. If a stall is needed, contact CEP 3-5 days prior to each show to verify availability. NON-SHOWING HORSES STABLING MUST PAY FOR A STALL AND WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO RENT STALLS IF THEY ARE NOT SOLD OUT. The following is the policy regarding non-showing horses:

- ⇒ Owners that have actively showing horses will be allowed to bring one non-showing horse at no charge
 - ⇒ Owners that do not have a horse actively competing may bring non-showing horses and pay a \$100 Non-Showing Horse Fee
 - ⇒ Trainers are permitted to bring non-showing horses at no charge as long as such horses are owned by the trainer
- An entry blank with proper signatures must be filled out for each non-showing horse on the grounds. Please stop by the horse show office upon arrival, PRIOR to unloading your non-showing horse.

Arrival Reminders

Move-in begins Monday, April 3rd between the hours of 12:00pm and 6:00pm. Due to other shows at Westworld the weekend before and the facility needing to clean stalls before we can move in, there is no set-up, equipment drop-off or move-in before 12:00 noon or any days prior. If you are coming from out-of-state and wish to arrive early, it is recommended that you contact a local trainer to inquire about stalls at their barn until the designated move-in date and time. Due to equine health requirements, horses must arrive between 12:00pm and 6:00pm on move-in day and 8:00am to 6:00pm on all other days during the show.

Entry Closing Date, Late Fee

Entries must be received by the entry closing date ... electronic entries must be completed and submitted by the entry closing date and postal entries must be postmarked by the entry closing date and received within seven days to avoid the \$50 Late Fee. Entries submitted or postmarked after the entry closing date or at the show will be charged a \$50 Late Fee.

Entry Reminders / Registration Fee / Schooling Fee / Show Scratches

If you are showing in USEF classes only, use the 'USEF' Entry Blank and submit Registration Fee and Stall Fee. If you are showing in USHJA Outreach classes only, use the 'OR' Entry Blank and submit the Registration Fee and appropriate Stall Fee (\$275, \$175 or other). If you are showing in both USEF and USHJA Outreach classes, use both entry blanks, listing USEF classes on the 'USEF' Entry Blank and Outreach classes on the 'OR' Entry Blank. In this case, only submit the Registration Fee and Stall Fee from the 'USEF' Entry Blank, not both. Every horse entered must pay a \$100 Registration Fee. The Registration Fee is a single, all-inclusive fee that covers the office charge, entry processing and medical coverage before and during the show. A new \$25 Schooling Fee will be charged for every horse entered to offset the cost of schooling in the rings on warm-up day and before and after classes during the show. This fee is mandatory and will be charged to every entry. In the event of a show scratch after the entry closing date, this Registration Fee is non-refundable and forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee. The Stall Fee can be credited or refunded as long as the stall has not been used. This applies to all USEF and USHJA Outreach entries.

General Rules & Regulations

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

- a) If you plan to show in USEF classes only, complete the USEF Entry Blank and submit a \$100 Registration Fee and \$275 Stall Fee. If you plan to show in USHJA Outreach classes only, and your horse will arrive on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, complete the Outreach Entry Blank and submit the \$100 Registration Fee and \$275 Stall Fee. If you plan to show in USHJA Outreach classes only, and your horse will arrive on Thursday or after, complete the Outreach Entry Blank and submit the \$100 Registration Fee and \$175 Stall Fee. If you plan to show in both USEF and USHJA Outreach classes, you must complete both entry blanks (the USEF requires that USEF classes be listed on a USEF Entry Blank and USHJA Outreach classes be listed on a USHJA Outreach Entry Blank), but only pay the \$100 Registration Fee and \$275 Stall Fee once on the USEF Entry Blank ... do not send in money on the USHJA Outreach Entry Blank.
- b) If postal mailing your entries, you may include a check for this amount or complete the credit card section on the entry blank ... checks will be deposited and credit cards run on the entry closing date. If scanning and/or emailing your entry, complete the credit card section on the entry blank, and it will be run on the entry closing date. If entering through Horseshowing.com, there is no fee to use the service and the Registration / Stall Fee is charged immediately upon submission. If using Equestrianconnect.com, there may be a small fee charged by the service and the credit card will be run on the entry closing date. A 3% Convenience Fee will apply for all retail credit card transactions and is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- c) When first checking in at the horse show office, whether done by the owner or trainer, back numbers can be picked up as long as all entries are complete and all requirements are met. If the Registration / Stall Fee was paid by check, then another signed, open check or credit card must be lodged with the office. If your trainer is picking up your number and doesn't have any form of payment for your account, they may guarantee your payment on their trainer account until such time you can come to the office and provide a form of payment. If, upon closeout, no form of payment has been provided, trainers must pay these charges on their Trainer Account. A 3% Convenience Fee will apply for all retail credit card transactions and is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- d) Entries received by the closing date and adhering to the entry procedure are accepted with no penalty. Late entries, incomplete entries including entries made without sufficient payment and entries made at the show must pay a one-time \$50 Post Entry Fee.

REGISTRATION FEE: Every horse must pay a \$100 Registration Fee when submitting entries for either show. If entering both shows, only pay this \$100 Registration Fee on the USEF Entry Blank. If the entry is on-time, properly completed and includes the required fees, the entry will be accepted without penalty. This fee is not refundable under any circumstances and is forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee if you show scratch after the entry closing date.

STABLING: Stalls are permanent, 10'x12', with rubber-matted dirt floors and full sliding doors and rent for \$275 per week. Stalls for horses entered only in Outreach classes and moved into on Thursday or after are \$175. Stalls may not be shared or resold.

GROUND'S FEE: A Ground's Fee of \$50 per day will be charged for horses that are showing and have not purchased a stall. This allows a horse to haul-in, tie to a trailer and show. Horses claiming a Ground's Fee but using a stall, even briefly, will be charged a full stall fee.

ADDING REGULAR CLASSES: If you wish to add a regular class after initially checking in and picking up your number, you must do so by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is to be held. Adds after this time or same day adds will only be allowed if the schedule in that ring is not full. The yellow copy of the Add / Scratch Form **MUST** be given to the starter **BEFORE** the start of the class that was added. There is no charge to add a regular class.

SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES: If you do not intend to show in a regular class you have entered, you **MUST** scratch it on an Add / Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the horse show office by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. There will be no charge for this. Scratches after this time or same day scratches will be charged a \$10 per class fee and must be done in the horse show office **BEFORE** the start of the class. Scratches may not be done after a class has started. Scratching at the back gate or simply not showing up will result in forfeiture of the entry fee.

ADDING / SCRATCHING SPECIAL CLASSES: Adds and scratches should be made by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day

before the class is held. Adds after this time, if accepted, will pay a Post Entry Fee and must go first in the order. Scratches from these classes must be done in the horse show office by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. Scratches after this time may forfeit the entry fee unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch.

SHOW SCRATCH (a horse entered but scratched from the entire show prior to going in any classes): On or before the closing date of entries, all fees shall be waived. If you sent in a check or put credit card information on your entry blank, they will be shredded. **After the closing date of entries, the \$100 Registration Fee is not refundable under any circumstances and is forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee.** Any other fees paid in advance, including the Stall Fee (as long as the horse didn't use a stall), are fully refundable. All show scratches must be submitted in writing before the end of the show. No show scratch refund requests will be processed after the show is over.

EQUITATION ENTRIES: Equitation riders must wear the number of the horse they are entered on. Numbers are assigned to horses, not riders. If a rider wishes to change horses for an equitation class, they may do so without penalty; however, the proper paperwork must be completed in the show office prior to the start of the class. Exhibitors changing horses without notifying the office will forfeit their entry fee on the original horse and be charged the entry fee plus an RDNE Fee on the new horse.

SUBSTITUTIONS: With a vet's certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a show scratched horse as long as the scratched horse has not shown in any classes and both horses are registered under the same trainer. The scratched horse's Registration Fee is transferred to the substituted horse.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense. A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$50.00)! Accounts will be given seven (7) days to be paid in full with cash or credit card or they will be turned into the USEF for disciplinary action.

General Rules & Regulations

RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter): Entries that show in a class not properly entered will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$25 RDNE Fee. Starters are not responsible for keeping you out of classes that you are not officially entered in. If you 'crash' the gate and go into a class you are not entered in in a ring that is closed to same day adds, you will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$50 RDNE Fee.

CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS: Visa, Mastercard and Discover can be used for payment of your Registration / Stall Fee when entering and your final bill when closing out. All retail credit card transactions will incur a 3% Convenience Fee. Sorry, but American Express is not accepted. Convenience Fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

PRIZEMONEY / AWARDS: Prize money checks will be mailed or hand-delivered to the owner within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. Social Security number of OWNER or PAYEE is required before any prize money will be paid. All purses and add-backs shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 12%, 5th - 11% and 6th - 10%. Ribbons shall be awarded to eighth place in all regular classes and classics unless otherwise stated.

EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: See the full page in this prize list for Equine Health Requirements to attend the show.

MONEY / STAKE CLASS ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a money, stake and/or jackpot class, entry must have entered and shown in at least one other class in the same section at the show, unless otherwise stated.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: USEF GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. **GR1301.8.** The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

DOGS: USEF GR1301.6 Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7.

PARKING: The parking of vehicles and horse trailers is not permitted in the barn areas. Illegal parking anywhere will result in a fine of \$50 per occurrence. This fine will be placed on your horse show account and

becomes a part of your financial obligation to the show. Further fines, ticketing and/or towing will result for multiple offenders. Trainers may be held accountable for any parking fines incurred by their staff.

SHAVINGS: Contract requirements supersede USEF GR1216.7. Competitors are prohibited from bringing their own shavings onto Westworld property for either personal or commercial use. Shavings must be purchased through the facility concession on the grounds.

MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles in every barn. Violations shall be subject to a \$50 fine per occurrence.

DAMAGE / HOLES IN STALLS & BARN WALLS: Exhibitors will be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees, and will be billed accordingly. Holes punched in any stall or barn wall, or any use of an existing hole, will result in a fine of \$25 per hole punched or used, regardless of who made the hole. Facility staff inspect stalls daily and will charge the horse show for any violations of this rule.

CONFLICTS: Management cannot allow conflicts to hold up any rings. Riders with potential conflicts must arrange their jumping order with the starters so that they will not hold up a class. Trainer conflicts cannot be recognized. If you are a trainer, be sure to bring enough help to get your horses and clients to the rings in a timely manner or only bring a manageable number of horses if you are limited in the help you have.

TRAINER SPLITS: These shows offer a service that allows trainers to have their tack stalls split evenly amongst their client's horse show bills by completing a Trainer Split Form. See the office for deadlines for submitting this form. Uncollected splits will revert back to the trainer.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. A Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required.

JOGGING: USEF HU118.3 Option A - Horses / ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses / ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

USEF RULE GR901.11: The horse show policies stated herein regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of USEF Rule GR901.11.

ARENAS: Hunter 1 is 260'x150'; Hunter 2 is 240'x135'; Jumper Show Ring is 300'x150'; Hunter Warm-up Rings are 200'x90'; Jumper Warm-Up Ring is 300'x150'. Footing is a sand / dirt / clay mix.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4 H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE (GR208.1)

For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a Federation fee will be collected (a portion of the fee shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee.

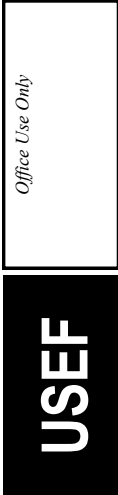

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and Scottsdale Spring Classic Horse Show ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. 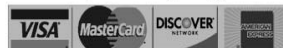


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
