

*** REMINDER OF IMPORTANT USEF RULE REGARDING BACK NUMBERS ***

The USEF passed a new rule in 2024 requiring that all horses, whenever they leave their stall during a show for any reason (to show, bathe, lunging, walking, schooling, etc.) must display their horse show back number. Anytime you take a horse out of its stall, be sure to display the horse's number on the horse or on the rider / handler with the horse. This applies to all horses on the grounds during show days and show hours, even non-showing horses and horses that aren't scheduled to show until later in the week.

EQUINE HEALTH DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS



USEF requirements, combined with management and facility policies, are designed to protect your horse and other horses participating in any show at Westworld. These measures are designed to decrease the risk of introduction or spread of contagious or infectious disease.

Horses may only arrive during the hours published in this prize list. Arrivals at any other time must be approved in advance by emailing CEP at cepshows@aol.com at least 72 hours prior to arrival.

UPON ARRIVAL, YOU MUST POSSESS A COMPLETED "EQUINE HEALTH DOCUMENT" AND BE PREPARED TO SHOW SUCH DOCUMENT UPON REQUEST. THIS SIMPLIFIED, SINGLE-PAGE DOCUMENT ATTESTS TO THE FOLLOWING:

HORSE HEALTH VERIFICATION (required by show management)

Verifies that all horse(s) on your trailer have been healthy with no sign of infectious disease and have not had a temperature above 101.5°F within 72 hours of arrival, nor have been around any horses or at any barn or facility that had any horses that were sick or under any type of quarantine within 30 days of arrival. This is required for all horses entering the show grounds whether showing or not.

PROOF OF VACCINATION (required by USEF)

Attests to the fact that you are in possession of (and must be shown upon request) a signed statement or vaccination record from a veterinarian that the horse(s) have been vaccinated against:

Equine Influenza (EIV) within 6 months of the first show day Rhinopneumonitis (EHV 1 and EHV 4) within 6 months of the first show day

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for the next show.

NEGATIVE COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATE (required by Westworld and the State of Arizona)

Attests to the fact that all horses arriving at the show must have (and must be shown upon request):

Negative Coggins for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) dated within 12 months of the first show day

In addition, horses coming from out-of-state must have (and must be shown upon request):

A Health Certificate dated within 30 (thirty) days of the first show day

This EQUINE HEALTH DOCUMENT (available at www.cepshows.com) that covers all horses you are bringing onto the show grounds should be in your possession upon arrival and must be presented upon request. Horses that leave during a show week and then return the same week, as well as "haul-ins" that come in daily, need not present a new document each time they return. Horses leaving after the first show and then returning for the second show must present a new document. CEP reserves the right to amend this policy if unforeseen circumstances warrant.

- Must have competed in at least one Outreach Series Competition
- Horses do not need to be registered or microchipped in order to participate. Those wishing to have their horses earn Outreach points must record them with USHJA (\$20/annual or \$75/lifetime)

Due to Equine Health Requirements, arrivals on all other days must take place between 8:00am and 6:00pm

SCHOOLING IN THE SHOW RINGS

Jumper Ring: On warm-up days (Tuesdays), fences will be set in the jumper ring from 11:00am to 5:00pm for open schooling. There is no fee to school over fences and no set times and heights. You may jump and set the fences as you wish. Multiple riders will be allowed at the same time, although trainers and riders are requested to exercise good judgement when it comes to an overcrowded ring. Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses in the ring at any given time. No other schooling over fences will be permitted at any time during the show week.

Hunter Rings: Schooling is permitted on warm-up days (Tuesdays) from 10:00am to 5:00pm and in the morning of show days as per the published daily schedule. Each afternoon, hunter rings may be open for schooling, time and weather permitting. Exception: rings may be closed early in the afternoon and / or the following morning if a special class is being held (derby, special class, etc.) and the course is set for it. See daily schedule.

HOW TO ENTER

Entry closing date is Monday, September 30th, 2024.

Online entries must be submitted by this date to be considered on time. Entries submitted after this date or submitted without proper deposits are considered late / incomplete and will incur a \$50 Late Fee.

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- Go to www.horseshowing.com and follow the links to Enter Shows / Click Here To Enter Online
- 2) Log in (or create account if this is your first time)
- 3) Complete entry / class information as required
- 4) For stall reservation, choose one of the following:
 - a) If showing in any classes in the USEF part of the show, select Regular Stall @ \$350
 - b) If showing in Outreach classes ONLY and your horse will be stabled anytime Thursday thru Sunday, select Outreach Stall @ \$225 (discounted rate for Outreach entries only staying four or less days Thu thru Sun)
 - c) If showing in Outreach classes only and horse will be stabled prior to Thursday, select Regular Stall @ \$350
 - d) If you are planning to haul-in daily and not use a stall, select Haul-In Fee @ \$50
- 5) Be sure to sign the online USEF Waiver and include it with your entry when you submit.
- 6) Payment must accompany your entry and may be done in one of two ways:
 - a) If you wish to pay by credit card, click on the "Credit Card" option, complete the information and submit your entry. This transaction will be charged immediately upon submission. A non-refundable 3% Convenience Fee will be added to all credit card transactions. If you wish to have your final bill upon closeout charged to this same card, check the "Save Card" option before submitting.
- b) If you wish to pay by check, click on the "Check" option and submit your entry. Then postal mail a check, payable to CEP, 29455 N Cave Creek Road, Suite 118-430, Cave Creek, AZ 85331. Be sure to write the horse's show name on the memo line. This check must be received by the entry closing date. Checks received AFTER entry closing date or not received at all will result in a \$50 Late Fee.
- 7) If you pay with credit card, and checked the "Save Card" option, your card will be charged when closing out at the end of the show. If you pay with credit card and do not check the "Save Card" option or you pay by check, you will be required to do a credit card swipe or leave a signed, blank check with the office for payment of the account upon checking in. Otherwise, the account will be charged to the Trainer upon closeout.

If a ring's schedule is not full and is open to same day adds, entries may compete in these classes as many times as they wish. You may even add warm-up rounds at the gate. Warm-Up rounds may be ridden before or after your regular classes. Warm-up rounds may be ridden by any rider, including professionals (exception: for Pony and Children's Pony warm-ups, riders must be eligible to compete on a pony and all USEF rules regarding riders and ponies will apply). NOTE: Classes #401 and #408 are free to enter and are restricted to those showing in the Young Hunter sections only.

USEF CLASSICS & SPECIAL CLASSES

"Deadline" refers to 5:00pm or when the office closes, whichever comes first, the day before such class is held. Entries into any Special Classes should be made by the deadline. Entries after the deadline, if accepted, will pay a Post Entry Fee as noted and may go first in the order. Scratches from Special Classes must be conducted in the horse show office by the deadline to receive full credit. Scratches after the deadline must be done at least one hour prior to the start of the class and will incur a Scratch Fee as noted. Scratches less than one hour prior to the start of the class will forfeit the entry fee unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch. Unless otherwise specified, classes with less than six entries at the deadline will be canceled or combined at management's discretion. Once canceled or combined, classes will not be uncanceled or uncombined under any circumstances. 

CEP 3'3" Open Equitation Championship

- Open to all riders, including trainers / professionals
- Riders must compete in at least one hunter or equitation class at 3'3" or higher, or in at least one jumper class at 1.00m or higher, at the same show

CEP 3'0" Equitation Championship

- Open to Children's and Adult Amateur riders
- Riders must compete in at least one hunter or equitation class at 3'0" or 3'3", or in at least one jumper class at 0.90m or 1.00m, at the same show
- Riders competing in any class with fences exceeding 3'3" or 1.00m are ineligible for this championship

CEP Outreach 2'6" Equitation Championship

- Open to Children's and Adult Amateur riders competing in Outreach classes at the same show
- Riders must compete in at least one Outreach hunter or equitation class at 2'6" or 2'9", or in at least one Outreach jumper class at 0.70m or 0.80m, at the same show
- Riders competing in any class with fences exceeding 2'9" or 0.80m are ineligible for this championship

Each championship will consist of two rounds over fences (an equitation round and a gymnastics round) followed by a flat phase of the top eight. Awards and gift certificates will be presented to the top eight in each final. And the best part? ELIGIBILITY: Zone HOTY Championship classes are open to all competitors. However, to be eligible for Zone Championship awards and bonus points, the following eligibility requirements must be met: A) Horse owner, rider and trainer must be Active/Competing members of USHJA and USEF ... Membership must be active on or before the first day of competition as outlined in the USEF rulebook; B) Horses must be recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA. In Hunter and Jumper sections the owner or recorded leasee of the horse must reside within Zone 8. In Equitation sections the rider must reside within Zone 8.

ENTERING: All entries that meet the eligibility requirements as outlined above are automatically entered into the Zone 8 Championship. You do not need to enter these separately. All eligibility requirements must be met prior to the first day of the show and no adjustments or clarifications to these requirements may be made after the show starts. You are responsible to insure proper compliance and eligibility prior to the first day of the show if you wish to be considered for a Zone 8 Championship. NO EXCEPTIONS! There is no fee or any additional charges to compete in the USHJA Zone 8 Championships.

HUNTER QUALIFYING CLASSES / **BONUS POINTS:** The first three classes from each hunter section (two over fences and the under saddle) are designated as Zone 8 Championship classes. The eligible entry with the highest point total from the championship chart from these three classes will be crowned Zone 8 Champion in their respective section. In addition to regular points being awarded in these three classes, the top eight eligible placings will also earn bonus points towards zone HOTY awards as follows: 1st -40 pts, 2nd - 30 pts, 3rd - 20 pts, 4th - 12 pts, 5th - 10 pts, 6th - 8 pts, 7th - 6 pts, 8th - 4 pts. The Champion and Reserve Champion will also earn an extra 80 points and 48 points respectively.

JUMPER QUALIFYING CLASSES / **BONUS POINTS:** Three classes in each jumper section will count as the designated Zone 8 Championship classes. The eligible entry with the highest point total from these three classes will be crowned Zone 8 Champion in their respective sections. In addition to regular points being awarded in these three classes, the top eight eligible placings will also earn bonus points towards zone HOTY awards as follows: 1st - 40 pts, 2nd - 30 pts, 3rd - 20 pts, 4th - 12 pts, 5th - 10 pts, 6th - 8 pts, 7th - 6 pts, 8th - 4 pts. No Champion or Reserve Champion bonus points awarded in jumpers.

EQUITATION QUALIFYING CLASSES / **BONUS POINTS**: The three classes from each equitation section (two over fences and the equitation flat) are designated as Zone 8 Championship classes. The eligible rider with the highest point total from the championship chart from these three classes will be crowned Zone 8 Champion in their respective sections. In addition to regular points being awarded in these three classes, the top eight eligible placings will also earn bonus points towards zone HOTY awards as follows: 1st -40 pts, 2nd - 30 pts, 3rd - 20 pts, 4th - 12 pts, 5th - 10 pts, 6th - 8 pts, 7th - 6 pts, 8th - 4 pts. The Champion and Reserve Champion will also earn an extra 80 points and 48 points respectively.

2024 ZONE 8 CHAMPIONSHIP SECTIONS OFFERED & CLASSES TO COUNT

If you keep close track of your points through the USEF, be sure to verify that they have properly credited your standings with these bonus points. And remember, these Special Bonus Points counting towards the zone HOTY awards are only for the top six or eight eligible entries in each of the zone championship classes. General Rules & Regulations

REGISTRATION FEE: Every horse must pay a \$125 Registration Fee when submitting entries for each show. This fee includes office fees, processing and costs, online access fees, medical coverage and facility access.

STABLING: All stalls are permanent, 10'x12' with full doors and rubber matted floors, and rent for \$350 per show. Horses showing only in Outreach classes on Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday may get an Outreach Stall for \$225 (Thursday thru Sunday). Outreach horses occupying stalls prior to Thursday must pay the full \$350 stall fee. Day Stalls are not available. Stalls are non-transferable and may not be shared or resold.

SHAVINGS: Contract requirements supersede USEF GR1216.7. Competitors are prohibited from bringing their own shavings or having such delivered onto Westworld property for any use. Shavings must be purchased through the facility concession on the grounds.

GROUNDS FEE: A one-time Grounds Fee of \$50 will be charged for horses that are showing and have not purchased a stall. This allows a horse to haul-in, tie to a trailer and show up to three days. If showing for four or more days, a full weekly stall must be purchased. Horses claiming a Grounds Fee but using a stall, even briefly, will be charged a stall fee.

ADDING REGULAR CLASSES: If you wish to add a regular class after initially checking in and picking up your number, you must do so by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is to be held. Adds after this time or same day adds will only be allowed if the schedule in that ring is not full. The yellow copy of the Add / Scratch Form MUST be given to the starter BEFORE the start of the class that was added. There is no charge to add a regular class. Should a starter close you out of a class that you added, but you failed to deliver the add sheet prior to the start of the class, you will forfeit the entry fee.

SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES: If you do not intend to show in a regular class you have entered, you MUST scratch it on an Add / Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the horse show office by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. There will be no charge for this. Scratches after this time or same day scratches will be charged a \$10 per class fee and must be done in the horse show office BEFORE the start of the class. Scratches may not be done after a class has started. Scratching at the back gate or simply not showing up for your class will result in forfeiture of the entry fee.

ADDING / SCRATCHING SPECIAL CLASSES: Adds and scratches should be made by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. Adds after this time, if accepted, will pay a Post Entry Fee and must go first in the order. Scratches from these classes must be done in the horse show office by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. Scratches after this time will forfeit the entry fee unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch. See specific exceptions on Special Classes pages.

EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: See the full page in this prize list for Equine Health Requirements to attend the show.

SHOW SCRATCH (a horse entered but scratched from the entire show prior to going in any classes): On or before the closing date of entries: If you entered via credit card, it will be refunded (except for the Convenience Fee, which is fully non-refundable); If you sent in a check, it will be shredded (checks are not deposited before the entry closing date). After the closing date of entries, the \$125 Registration Fee is not refundable under any circumstances and is forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee. Any other fees paid in advance, including the Stall Fee (as long as the horse didn't use a stall), are fully refundable (except for the Convenience Fee, which is fully non-refundable). Show scratches in which the horse doesn't come to the show must be done by the start of the show. Show scratches after the start of the show must be requested before the end of the show. No show scratch refund requests will be processed after the show is over.

EQUITATION ENTRIES: Equitation riders must wear the number of the horse they are entered on. Numbers are assigned to horses, not riders. If a rider wishes to change horses for an equitation class, they may do so without penalty; however, the proper paperwork must be completed in the show office prior to the start of the class. Exhibitors changing horses without notifying the office will forfeit their entry fee on the original horse and be charged the entry fee plus an RDNE Fee on the new horse.

SUBSTITUTIONS: With a vet's certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a show scratched horse as long as the scratched horse has not shown in any classes and both horses are registered under the same trainer. The scratched horse's Registration Fee and Stall Fee are transferred to the substituted horse with no penalty or charge.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense. A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$50.00)! Accounts will be given seven (7) days to be paid in full with cash or credit card or they will be turned into the USEF for disciplinary action.

RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter): Entries that show in a class not properly entered will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$25 RDNE Fee. Starters are not responsible for keeping you out of classes that you are not officially entered in. If you 'crash' the gate and go into a class you are not entered in in a ring that is closed to same day adds, you will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$50 RDNE Fee.

CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS: Visa, Mastercard and Discover can be used for payment of your Registration Fee when entering and your final bill when closing out in the horse show office. All retail credit card transactions will incur a 3% Convenience Fee. Sorry, but American Express is not accepted. Convenience Fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

PRIZEMONEY / **AWARDS:** Prize money checks will be mailed to the owner or listed payee within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. Social Security number of OWNER or PAYEE is required before any prize money will be paid. All purses and add-backs shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 12%, 5th - 11% and 6th - 10%. Ribbons shall be awarded to eighth place in all regular classes and classics unless otherwise stated.

General Rules & Regulations

MONEY / **STAKE CLASS ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible for a money, stake and/or jackpot class, entry must have entered and shown in at least one other class in the same section at the show, unless otherwise stated.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

DOGS: USEF GR1301.6 Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7.

PARKING: The parking of vehicles and horse trailers is not permitted in the barn areas. Illegal parking anywhere will result in a fine of \$50 per occurrence. This fine will be placed on your horse show account and becomes a part of your financial obligation to the show. Further fines, ticketing and/or towing will result for multiple offenders. Trainers may be held accountable for any parking fines incurred by their staff.

MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles in every barn. Violations shall be subject to a \$50 fine per occurrence.

DAMAGE / HOLES IN STALLS & BARN WALLS: Exhibitors will be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees, and will be billed accordingly. Holes punched in any stall or barn wall, or any use of an existing hole, will result in a fine of \$25 per hole punched or used, regardless of who made the hole. Facility staff inspect stalls daily and will charge the horse show for any violations

CONFLICTS: Management cannot allow conflicts to hold up any rings. Riders with potential conflicts must arrange their jumping order with the starters so that they will not hold up a class. Trainer conflicts cannot be recognized. If you are a trainer, be sure to bring enough help to get your horses and clients to the rings in a timely manner or only bring a manageable number of horses if you are limited in the help you have.

TRAINER SPLITS: These shows offer a service that allows trainers to have their tack stalls split evenly amongst their client's horse show bills by completing a Trainer Split Form. See the office for deadlines for submitting this form. Uncollected splits will revert back to the trainer.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. A Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required.

JOGGING: USEF HU118.3 Option A - Horses / ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses / ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

USEF RULE GR901.11: The horse show policies stated herein regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of USEF Rule GR901.11.

ARENAS: Hunter 1 is 260'x150'; Hunter 2 is 240'x150'; Jumper Show Ring is 270'x150'; Hunter Warm-up Rings are 200'x90'; Jumper Warm-Up Ring is 180'x160'. Footing is a sand / dirt / clay mix.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

GOLF CARTS: The golf cart rental company used by the show does not rent to individual exhibitors. Therefore, if you need a golf cart, please let us know not later than the entry closing date and we will order one for you. You may specify two passenger or four passenger, but there are no guarantees as we get what is available. Prices will be at current market (to be determined). Once delivered, golf carts may not be canceled. You are welcome to find another rental company and order carts directly from them.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE (GR208.1)

For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a Federation Fee will be collected (a portion of the fee shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee.

IMPORTANT POLICIES OF THE HORSE SHOW

Arrival Reminders

Move-in is each Monday between the hours of 1:00pm and 6:00pm. If you wish to arrive on any other day or at a time earlier than or later than listed, contact CEP at cepshows@aol.com or entries@cepshows.com at least one week prior to move-in day. We will contact Westworld and find out if such early arrival can be accommodated. If so, early arrival stalls are \$40 each per night. Due to equine health requirements, horses must arrive between 1:00pm and 6:00pm on move-in days and 8:00am to 6:00pm on all other days during the show week.

Entry Closing Date / Paying By Check / Late Fee

Entries must be submitted online by the entry closing date. Credit card is the preferred method of payment. If paying your deposit by check, the check must be postal mailed and received by the entry closing date. If the check is received after the entry closing date or not received at all, the account will incur a \$50 Late Fee regardless of when the entry was submitted.

Registration Fee

Every horse entered must pay a \$125 Registration Fee. The Registration Fee is a single, all-inclusive fee that covers the office charge, entry processing, online portal access, equipment and supplies, arena access and medical coverage before and during the show.

Show Scratches

If you show scratch your horse on or before the entry closing date, all deposits will be refunded except for any Credit Card Convenience Fees already incurred. In the event of a show scratch after the entry closing date, the Registration Fee is non-refundable and forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee. The Stall Fee can be credited or refunded as long as the stall has not been used.

Class Adds & Scratches, Same Day Class Adds

All entries for the next day, including adds and scratches, must be made by the deadline (5:00pm or the close of the office, whichever comes first) each day. This allows the next day's schedule to be created, with class counts and times, and made available to everyone by 6:00pm. Any changes made after this deadline, if accepted, will be considered SAME DAY and will fall under the SAME DAY policy. CEP allows same-day adds as long as the schedule in each ring is not full. If the following day's schedule in a ring is full at the deadline, then that ring is declared "closed" and will not allow same day adds. To keep from getting shut out of classes under these conditions, exhibitors are urged to verify their entries for the next day prior to the deadline.

Canceling And Combining Of Classes

At the deadline each day, the schedule for the next day is created. Classes with less than the entry minimums are either canceled or combined with other classes. Then the schedule is published, the class sheets are printed and judge's cards finalized. Please note that any classes canceled or combined WILL NOT BE UNCANCELED OR UNCOMBINED, regardless of how many entries actually show or wish to show in them. So be sure you are entered in all your desired classes by the deadline the day before.

Scratch Your Classes BEFORE They Start

Be sure to scratch any classes you have entered that you won't be showing in BEFORE the classes start in the horse show office. If you don't scratch them at all, try to scratch them after they have started or simply tell the starter you're not going in them, there is no refund. To maintain an accurate schedule for the competitors, we need to know if you plan to show or not.

Non-Showing Horses

Non-showing horses are permitted at all CEP shows. NON-SHOWING HORSES STABLING MUST PAY FOR A STALL AND WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO RENT STALLS IF THEY ARE NOT SOLD OUT. The following is the policy regarding non-showing horses:

- ⇒ Owners that have actively showing horses will be allowed to bring one non-showing horse at no additional charge ... any others must pay a \$100 Non-Showing Horse Fee
- ⇒ Owners that do not have a horse actively competing may bring non-showing horses and pay a \$100 Non-Showing Horse Fee
- ⇒ Trainers may bring non-showing horses at no additional charge as long as such horses are owned by the trainer ... these must be owned by the trainer, not just represented or agented

An entry blank release with proper signatures must be filled out for each non-showing horse on the grounds. A back number will be issued and must be worn by the horse or handler anytime the horse is taken out of its stall for any reason during the show

New USEF Number Rule

Remember that the USEF passed a new rule requiring that all horses, whenever they leave their stall for any reason (show, bathe, lunging, walking, schooling, etc.) must wear their show number. So anytime you take a horse out of its stall, be sure to display the horse's number somewhere on its body or on the individual riding / leading / handling the horse.
